STATEMENT OF FACTS

Background of David Russell Williams:

1. David "Russell" Williams is 47 years old (D.O.B.: March 7, 1963). From 1995-July 2009, he lived with his wife, Mary Elizabeth Harriman, at 545 Wilkie Dr., in Ottawa. In 2004, they purchased a cottage residence at 62 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed. In December, 2009, Mr. Williams and Ms. Harriman moved from Wilkie Dr. to 473 Edison Ave., Ottawa.
2. At the time of these offences, Mr. Williams was a member of the Canadian Forces. At the time of the first offence he held the rank of Lieutenant Colonel, and in July, 2009 he was appointed Colonel as the Base Commander of 8 Wing at Canadian Forces Base (C.F.B.) Trenton.
3. Following his appointment as base commander, in command of a base of 3000 employees, Mr. Williams lived at his Tweed residence during the week and commuted to C.F.B. Trenton. He generally went to his home in Ottawa on weekends.

General Overview of the Investigation:

4. The investigation focussing on Russell Williams commenced following the disappearance of Jessica Lloyd who was last seen on January 28, 2010. Russell Williams became a suspect on February 4, 2010 and was interviewed by Det. Sgt. Jim Smyth of the Ontario Provincial Police (O.P.P.) behavioural science section on February 7, 2010. As a result of this interview Mr. Williams' involvement in the sexual assault and murder of Marie France Comeau on November 24, 2009 and Jessica Lloyd on January 29, 2010 was revealed. As well, he identified himself as the perpetrator for two break, enter and sexual assault occurrences that happened in Tweed in September, 2009.
5. As a result of subsequent interviews he was also implicated in 82 break and enter charges where, between 2007 and 2009, he attempted to enter or successfully entered residences with intent to commit an indictable offence, or where he committed an indictable offence. The break and enter charges, combined, cover 48 total residences, 23 located in the Tweed/Belleville area and 25 located in the Orleans area of Ottawa. Mr. Williams either broke into or attempted to break into all of these residences, many on more than one occasion. Only seventeen of the 48 homeowners reported to police that their homes had been broken into. Sixty-one of Mr. Williams' 82 offences, therefore, went undetected or unreported until after Mr. Williams' arrest. The Belleville and Ottawa Police Services (B.P.S. and O.P.S.) thoroughly investigated the 17 residences that were victims of Mr. Williams' occurrences but, up until February 7th, 2010, did not have a suspect for any of them.
6. Mr. Williams admitted that, beginning in the fall of 2007, in Tweed, he began breaking into houses and stealing women's lingerie and other clothing. He targeted houses where attractive young women lived. His stated age preference was women in their late teens to early 30s. He admitted to taking photographs inside the homes he broke into, specifically in the bedrooms, in the lingerie drawers and, often of himself wearing lingerie from that residence. He also often masturbated inside the homes. The majority of his break and enters were done overnight, often past midnight. He also admitted to breaking into more than one house per night on six different occasions. In the majority of the occurrences, none of the occupants were home. When he would return to his house, either in Tweed or Ottawa, after an occurrence, he would place any lingerie he had stolen in boxes or bags. When he accumulated too many items, he would dispose of them, including on two occasions (June 21st, 2008 and March 29th, 2009) where he brought items to different fields just outside of Ottawa and burned them.

7. Furthermore, after each occurrence, he would take pictures of the stolen lingerie and other items at his home. While doing so, he often modelled the lingerie and/or masturbated while wearing it, and took photographs of himself while doing so. He then downloaded all of his photographs (taken both during and after each occurrence) into a complex file folder system he created on his computer at his Ottawa home. These photographs are time and date stamped, and thus give one an idea of how long Mr. Williams was in a particular home and what he was doing while in there. For these reasons, a detailed description of the various folders is included. He also kept a log of all of his offences, which included the date, the location and the nature of the offence. He admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he stored the evidence of his break and enters, sexual assaults and murders on two hard drives. As will be outlined below, after Mr. Williams' arrest, police found these hard drives stored above the ceiling in the basement of his Ottawa home.
8. The following statement of facts traces the chronology and escalation of Mr. Williams' offences, from his first break and enter in the fall of 2007, culminating in the sexual assaults of Ms. Jane Doe and Ms. Massicotte and the rapes and murders of Ms. Comeau and Ms. Lloyd.
9. After Mr. Williams' arrest and confessions, the police continued to investigate all of these offences. They interviewed the victims of the break and enters as identified by Mr. Williams, the majority of whom, as noted above, were not aware that their home had been broken into. The summaries of each incident below, therefore, contain the victims' account of the incident, if any, and that of Mr. Williams.
10. Further police investigation also revealed that, contrary to Mr. Williams' stated age preference, females under the age of 18 were either the sole or joint targets of Mr. Williams in 13 of the homes he broke into.

Offences in chronological order:

Count 1: September 9, 2007 – Break, enter and commit theft – 66 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

11. This was the first of three break and enters to 66 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed. The occupants of this home have lived at this address since 2003 with their two children, one of whom was a 12 year old daughter at the time of these offences. They considered Mr. Williams and Ms. Harriman friends and had hosted them for dinner on numerous occasions. Mr. Williams often took the children tubing on Stoco Lake. Furthermore, on 6 occasions between the summer and December 2009, the daughter looked

after the Williams' cat at 62 Cosy Cove Lane. She thus had a key to their home. At the time of their interview with police in March 2010, the occupants were unaware of anyone ever having been in their home without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.

12. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 66 Cosy Cove Lane on 3 occasions, the first being on September 9th, 2007, when he broke into the home through an open door. He stole 6 pieces of female undergarments. On this occasion he took 25 photographs dated September 8th-9th, 2007, from 9:40 p.m. to 12:24 a.m. that he later downloaded onto his computer. These pictures show the inside of the daughter's bedroom, meaning he was in her room for at least 2 hours and 44 minutes. Pictures show the bedroom, with a focus on the young girl's underwear drawers, her closet and her bed. The décor shown in these pictures is clearly indicative of the room belonging to a young girl. Notably, there are 11 further pictures where Mr. Williams is either standing in a pair of female underwear showing his penis, standing in front of a mirror with a pink piece of clothing hanging from his erect penis, or laying on the bed naked, and masturbating with what appears to be the same piece of pink clothing. In 3 of these pictures, he has clearly ejaculated.

Count 2: September 28, 2007 – Break, enter and commit theft – 66 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

13. September 28, 2007 was Russell Williams' second break and enter, and was also at 66 Cosy Cove Lane. He admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that on this date he entered through an open door. He stole 2 pieces of underwear. He downloaded the photos onto his computer. A file on his computer revealed the following:
- a) 20 photos dated September 28th-29th, 2007, from 11:37 p.m. to 12:33 a.m. They, again, show the inside of the daughter's bedroom. Fourteen of the photos are close-ups of Mr. Williams either while he has clothing draped over his erect penis, or has his penis protruding from the underwear and skirt that he is wearing. He has clearly ejaculated in the last of these photos. The other 6 photos show the young girl's clothing either in an underwear drawer or in a clothes basket on the floor;
 - b) 22 photos dated September 29th, 2007, from 8:02-8:19 a.m. The photos show the inside of daughter's bedroom, meaning he either re-entered the home in the morning, or had stayed there since the previous night. The photos focus on her underwear drawer, her closet and her bed. In 10 of the pictures, Mr. Williams is either standing or laying on her bed naked, while masturbating with her underwear;

- c) 11 pictures dated September 29-30th, 2007, from 11:36 p.m. to 12:05 a.m. The pictures show the inside of the same bedroom, meaning Mr. Williams has re-entered 66 Cosy Cove Lane for what appears to be a third time during this time frame. Mr. Williams is visible in all of the pictures, and is either laying on the young girl's bed or standing in the room, and masturbating with her clothing. He is naked in all of the photos;
- d) 41 pictures dated September 29th, 2007, from 5:04-5:38 p.m. These pictures show Mr. Williams standing in an unmarked wooded area, either completely naked or wearing some of the daughter's underwear which is recognizable from previous photos inside the bedroom. In the photos, he is either masturbating or focusing the camera on his erect penis; and
- e) 4 photos, one of which is dated October 2nd, 2007, and 3 of which are dated March 30th, 2008. The former photo is of the items of clothing he stole from the daughter's bedroom on September 28th-30th, 2007. The latter 3 photos are of a newspaper clipping showing a Tweed Legion photo of the daughter and her classmates holding what appears to be a plaque or certificate.

Counts 3 and 4: October 19 & 20, 2007 – 2 counts of Break, enter and commit theft – 22 Greenwood Road, Tweed

- 14. At the time of their interview with police in April 2010, the occupants of 22 Greenwood Rd. in Tweed had lived at that address for 18 years with their twin daughters who were 11 years old at the time of these offences. They advised police that, in October 2007, they came home and noticed someone was in their house. They advised the police that this person was a tall male, and that he ran as soon as they came home. Upon entering their home, they did not notice anything missing. They did not initially report the incident to police, but 10 days later, after hearing of another unrelated break and enter in the area, they called police to report the incident. Other than that, they are unaware of anyone having been in their home without their permission nor have they ever noticed anything missing.
- 15. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 22 Greenwood Road twice, on October 19th and 20th, 2007. On October 19th, he broke into the home and stole 14 pieces of clothing (panties, bras and a bathing suit). On October 20th, he broke into the home through an open door and stole 9 pairs of panties. He downloaded the photographs he took onto his computer. In total, there are 7 unique photographs (with 7 duplicates of

those photos), dated October 19, 2007 between 9:31 and 9:38 p.m. These photos show what is obviously a young girl's bedroom with the focus on the bed and underwear drawers, undergarments in a dryer, and what appears to be an adult bedroom. There are then 3 unique photos (with 3 duplicates of those photos) dated October 20th from 10:44-10:48 pm. These show the inside of 3 different drawers, 2 of which obviously belong to young girls. There are also 19 photos dated October 20th-21st, 2007, of the items he stole from 22 Greenwood Rd., laid out collectively on a floor at an unknown location. The photos suggest that the items of clothing he stole from this address belong to both younger and adult females. There are also 28 photos dated April 27th, 2008. In these photos, Mr. Williams is wearing the items he stole from 22 Greenwood Rd. Most of the photos are close-ups of his midsection, and show his erect penis either protruding from the underwear or in his hand.

16. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that there was a "close call" on Greenwood Road in Tweed. Similar to the occupants' description of the incident, Mr. Williams noted that the owners came home once while he was inside the home and that he immediately ran away. He thought someone chased him on an A.T.V. but was not sure if anyone actually saw his face. He could not tell Det. Sgt. Smyth on which of the two dates this "close call" occurred.

Count 5: November 1, 2007 – Break, enter and commit theft – 38 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

17. The occupants of 38 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed, have lived in this house since 2006. When interviewed by police in March 2010, they were unaware of anyone ever having been in the home without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.
18. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he either broke into or tried to break into 38 Cosy Cove Lane on 3 occasions. The first occurred on November 1st, 2007. He admitted that he broke into the cottage through the patio door and stole 19 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into 3 subfolders one of which has 22 photos dated November 2nd, 2007, from 12:32-2:53 a.m. These photos show the inside of the cottage, meaning that Mr. Williams was there for at least 2 hours and 21 minutes. They show the inside of a bedroom, and focus on lingerie drawers, and lingerie laid out on a bed or on the floor. In 1 photo, Mr. Williams is kneeling on a bed wearing only a camisole, while holding his penis over top of several items of lingerie laid out on the bed. The other sub-folders contain photos dated November 3rd, 2007, and show Mr. Williams wearing

the lingerie he stole, often with his penis protruding from the underwear. In 4 photos, he is completely naked.

Count 6: March 15, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft - 72 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

19. At the time of their interview with police in March 2010, the occupants of 72 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed had lived at that address for 11 years, and have three young children. They were unaware of anyone having been in their home without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.
20. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he either broke into or tried to break into 72 Cosy Cove Lane on three occasions. The first occurred on March 15th, 2008, when he broke into the home through an open door. He stole 6 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras) and left. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer which revealed photos dated March 15-16th, 2008, from 11:09 p.m. to 12:35 a.m. They show the inside of the parents' bedroom, and thus indicate that Mr. Williams was inside the home for at least 1 hour and 26 minutes. Specifically, the photos show a bed, female underwear drawers and 6 items of lingerie laid out on the bed. There are a further 15 photos dated March 17th, 2008, and show close-ups of Mr. Williams' midsection while he wears the underwear he stole. In one of them, he is masturbating with a piece of clothing.

Count 7: March 28, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 61 McCrea Court, Tweed

21. The occupants of 61 McCrae Court, Tweed, have lived at this address since 1994. They have 2 daughters who have both gone off to school. At the time of their interview with police in March 2010, the occupants were unaware of anyone having been in their home without their permission, nor were they aware of anything missing.
22. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 61 McCrea Court through a patio door. He stole 14 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into 3 folders. One folder contains 20 photos dated March 28th, 2008, from 9:47-10:08 p.m. They show 3 different bedrooms inside the home, with a focus on lingerie in drawers and clothes baskets, on beds and on family pictures on walls. The other 2 folders contain a total of 34 pictures dated March 29-30th and April 27th, 2008. In all but 4 of these pictures, Mr. Williams is modelling the lingerie he stole from this address

in front of a mirror. His erect penis is visible in 10 of these pictures, including 4 close-ups.

Count 8: March 28, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 38 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

23. Russell Williams' second break and enter to the cottage at 38 Cosy Cove Lane happened on March 28th, 2008. Mr. Williams admitted that he broke into 38 Cosy Cove Lane through the patio door and stole 3 pairs of panties. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer. Two folders contain a total of 38 photos dated March 29th, 2008, from 2:24-5:15 a.m. These photos show the inside of the cottage, meaning Mr. Williams was there on this occasion for at least 2 hours and 51 minutes. Specifically, the photos show Mr. Williams taking pictures of himself while wearing only lingerie, including 4 photos where he has hung lingerie on his erect penis. There are also 5 photos of Mr. Williams lying on a twin-sized bed. In 4 of them, he is wearing panties and either showing his penis or masturbating. In the 5th photo, he is completely naked and masturbating. A second folder contains 11 photos, dated March 29th, 2008, from 12:19-12:23 p.m., 7 of which show Mr. Williams standing in front of a mirror wearing only female underwear.

Counts 9 and 10: April 4 and 5, 2008 – Two counts of Break, enter and commit theft – 52 Charles Court, Tweed

24. At the time of their interview with police in March 2010, the occupants of 52 Charles Court in Tweed had lived at this address for approximately 5 years.

25. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 52 Charles Court on 9 different occasions. The first two occurred on April 4th and 5th, 2008, when he broke into 52 Charles Ct., both times through an open door. He stole 22 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras) on April 4th and 27 pieces (panties and bras) on April 5th. He downloaded the photos he took of these occurrences onto his computer into 3 subfolders. One contains 15 photos dated both between 12:13-12:27 a.m. on April 5th and between 11:57 p.m.-12:09 a.m. on April 5th-6th. These photos show the inside of this home, as a photo of the homeowners is visible on a desk. They also show close-ups of lingerie in drawers, in a closet and laid out on a bed. A second folder contains 61 photos dated April 7th and 8th, 2008, of the stolen lingerie. The third folder, contains 6 photos, dated May 1st, 2008, of Mr. Williams wearing only the lingerie he stole, and show his erect penis either protruding from the underwear or in his hand and wrapped in underwear.

Count 11: May 9, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1723 Cara Crescent, Ottawa

26. This was the first time Russell Williams broke into or attempted to break into a residence in the Ottawa area. The occupants of 1723 Cara Crescent live there with their daughter, who was a young adult at the time of this occurrence. In the spring of 2008, the daughter noticed that some lingerie she had bought recently had gone missing. She was not sure exactly when she realized it was missing. On June 3rd, 2008, she realized that the screen to a living room window was also missing. A hook attached to that window was found on the back deck. The occupants therefore called the police, who arrived and investigated the home and its exterior. Beyond the screen, there was no other visible damage.

27. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1723 Cara Cres. on 2 occasions. The first was on May 9th, 2008, when he broke into the home through an open window. He stole 15 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into 3 subfolders. The first contained 17 photos dated May 10th, 2008, from 1:03-1:16 a.m. The pictures show the inside of the daughter's bedroom. These photos show pictures on the wall and trophies and plaques with the daughter's name on them, and clothing (mainly lingerie) in drawers, the closet, a clothes hamper and on the floor. A second folder contains 18 photos dated May 11th, 2008 and show the items of lingerie he stole from the daughter. A third folder contained 78 photos dated May 13th-27th, 2008. These photos show Mr. Williams wearing the lingerie he stole. Thirty-four of the photos are close-ups of his penis or of him masturbating. There are 5 photos that show close-ups of him having ejaculated.

Count 12: May 21, 2008 – Break and enter with intent to commit theft – 18 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

28. The occupants of the cottage at 18 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed, have owned it since 2003. When interviewed by police in April 2010, they were not aware of anyone having been in their cottage without their permission, nor of anything having gone missing.

29. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 18 Cosy Cove Lane on May 21st, 2008, by picking a lock on the front door. This took him 30 minutes. Once inside, he took 2 photos inside the home, but did not take anything.

Count 13: May 23, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft - 66 Cosy Cove Tweed

30. Russell Williams' final break in to 66 Cosy Cove Ln. occurred during daylight hours on May 23rd, 2008. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 66 Cosy Cove Lane on that date through an open door, stole 2 pairs of underwear, and took photographs. He downloaded the 27 photos onto his computer. Five photos are dated May 23rd, 2008, from 1:31-1:33 p.m. The pictures show the inside of the 13 year old daughter's bedroom. The photos show her bed, her underwear drawer and her clothing in her closet and in a clothes basket. There are also 17 photos dated May 23, 2008, between 1:50-2:00 p.m. The pictures are close-ups of Mr. Williams' penis. In them, Mr. Williams is either masturbating with clothing to the point of ejaculation or simply showing his penis. The backdrop of these photos is dark, making it impossible to determine where he is. The final 5 photos are also dated May 23rd, 2007, from 8:12-8:14 p.m. and show the stolen items of clothing.

Count 14: May 31, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 124 Charles Road, Tweed

31. When interviewed by police in March 2010, the occupants of 124 Charles Rd., Tweed, advised that they had not noticed anything to suggest that anyone had been in their home without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.

32. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into this house on two occasions, the first being May 31st, 2008. On that occasion, he broke into 124 Charles Rd., through an open window. He stole 11 pieces of clothing (lingerie and pyjamas), and left. He downloaded the photos he took of the occurrence onto his computer into 2 subfolders. The first contains 9 photos dated June 1st, 2008, from 12:11-12:24 a.m. They show the inside of the occupants' bedroom, and focus on lingerie, both in drawers and then placed on a bed by Mr. Williams, as well as family photographs on a dresser. The second folder contains 26 photos dated June 2nd, 2008, which show the lingerie he stole from 124 Charles Rd. The last 10 photos show Mr. Williams wearing the stolen lingerie. His erect penis is visible in 8 of the photos.

Counts 15 and 16: June 6, 2008 and June 7, 2008 – Attempt break and enter and Break, enter and commit theft – 7 Charles Court, Tweed

33. At the time of their police interview in March 2010, the occupants of 7 Charles Court in Tweed had lived at that house for 7 years. They were unaware of anyone ever having been in their house without their permission nor had they ever noticed anything missing.
34. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he either broke into or tried to break into 7 Charles Ct. on 4 different occasions. The first was on June 6th, 2008. On that date, he picked the lock to 7 Charles Ct. and went inside the home for approximately 5 minutes. He claimed he did not find anything of interest, so he left. He did not take any photos.
35. The next night, on June 7th, 2008, he broke into 7 Charles Ct., again, by picking the lock. This time, he stole 35 pieces of lingerie (bras and panties, and took photographs which he downloaded onto his computer in two subfolders. The first contains 4 photographs, dated June 7th, from 11:40-11:48 p.m. These photos show the inside of the home, and, specifically, a drawer containing a chequebook box with one of the occupants' name on it, an underwear drawer, and lingerie in a closet and on the floor. The second folder contains 34 photographs dated June 14th, 2008. These are photographs Mr. Williams took of the individual pieces of lingerie he stole from 7 Charles Ct.

Count 17: June 14, 2008 – Attempted break and enter – 577 Apollo Way, Ottawa

36. The occupants of 577 Apollo Way, Ottawa, live there with their 2 daughters, who were 13 and 16 years old at the time of this offence. During the summer of 2008, while cleaning the exterior of his house, the occupants noticed that someone had jammed an object into the door to the garage, and inferred from this that someone may have tried to break into the home. This was the only time that they suspected someone may have attempted to break into his residence. They did not see anything more, however, nor did they notice anything missing. They therefore did not report the matter to the police.
37. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he tried to break into 577 Apollo Way on June 14, 2008 through a window. However, he noted that the owners came home while he was making his attempt, so he fled the area. Mr. Williams believes that the owners saw him but they did not chase him, so he did not know if they reported it to the police.

Count 18: June 19, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1742 Cara Crescent, Ottawa

38. The occupant of 1742 Cara Cres., Ottawa, lives at this address with her 24 year-old daughter. On June 19th, 2008, the occupant was out of town. When she returned to Ottawa, she noticed that the front door was unlocked, which was unusual, and that the basement window had been pushed out into the window well. She did not notice anything missing inside the home. The daughter, however, who was also out of town at this time, returned and noticed that she was missing numerous pairs of underwear, several bras and a sex toy. They reported the incident to the police.
39. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1742 Cara Cres. through an open window. He stole 87 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras) and a sex toy. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence into four subfolders. The first contains 46 photos dated June 20th, 2008, from 1:57-3:34 a.m. They show the inside of the daughter's bedroom, and thus indicate that Mr. Williams was inside the house for at least 1 hour and 41 minutes. The photos show lingerie in drawers, on the floor and in baskets; a wall of pictures of the daughter and her friends and family; and photos of a wall showing the daughter's high school graduation diploma and photo. The last photo is of Mr. Williams coming out of the room at 3:34 a.m., wearing jeans and a sweatshirt and looking as though he is sweating. This folder also contains screenshots of the Ottawa Police website reporting on this and other occurrences. The other three folders contain a total of 146 photos dated June 20th and 21st, 2008. Twenty of them are close-ups of Mr. Williams' erect penis, often draped in an item of clothing, together with the sex toy. The remainder of the photos show the items he stole from this address. The last photo he has in this sequence is an undated photo of his penis on top of the sex toy with several items of clothing draped around it, with a caption "Merci beaucoup, [name of daughter]". Mr. Williams has obviously created this caption after he downloaded the photograph onto his computer.

Count 19: July 12, 2008 – Break, Enter and commit theft – 7 Charles Court, Tweed

40. On July 12th, 2008, Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 7 Charles Ct., Tweed, for a third time, again by picking the lock, and stole 17 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded photo he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two subfolders. The first contains four photos, three of which are dated July 12th from 11:09-11:14 p.m. These show the inside of the home, and, specifically, show lingerie and other clothing, in drawers and on the floor. The second folder

contains 18 photos dated July 20th-October 6th, 2008. These are photos Mr. Williams took of the pieces of lingerie he stole from the home on July 12, 2008.

Count 20: July 28, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 616 Simoneau Way, Ottawa

41. The occupant of 616 Simoneau Way, Ottawa, had, at the time of this offence, lived at this address with his wife and three daughters, then aged 9, 11 and 13 years. He was unaware of anyone having entered 616 Simoneau Way without his permission, nor had he ever noticed anything missing.
42. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 616 Simoneau Way on two occasions. The first occurred on July 28th, 2008, when he broke into the home through an open window. He could not identify who lived at the address, so he called her the “mystery little girl”. He stole 20 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, and the top half of a bathing suit). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 42 photos dated July 29th, 2008, from 3:01-4:05 a.m. Thirty-eight of them show the inside of what appears to be a young girl’s bedroom. The photos focus on clothing (mainly underwear) in drawers and laid out by Mr. Williams on the bed. There are also 2 photos of different frames containing seven photos each of young girls. Together, the décor of the room, the photos and the clothing suggest that this room belongs to a girl of approximately 10-12 years of age. There are two photos of Mr. Williams lying naked in the bed in this bedroom, masturbating, with a young female’s underwear laid out near his penis. The final four photos in this subfolder are framed photos of 3 different young girls, none of whom appears older than 12 years. The timing of the photos suggests he was inside the home for at least 1 hour and 4 minutes. The second folder contains 30 photos dated August 19th-26th, 2008. These photos show the clothing he stole from 616 Simoneau Way laid out on a sheet. There are also 7 photos of Mr. Williams wearing some of the items, including two close-ups of his midsection. Mr. Williams has ejaculated into the underwear in three of the photos.

Counts 21 and 22: August 1 and August 2, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft two times – 90 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

43. At the time of their interview with police in March 2010, the occupants of 90 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed, were unaware of anyone having been in their home without their permission, nor were they aware of anything missing. In February or March 2009, the occupant noticed that the window lock in

their spare bedroom was broken, but she was unsure of when this happened. She advised police that there was a sense of security in the community during this time period.

44. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into this house twice, on August 1st and 2nd, 2008. On both occasions, he broke into the home through an open window and stole seven items of lingerie (panties, bras and a slip) as well as a sundress. He downloaded the photos he took of these occurrences onto his computer into four folders. The first folder contains 17 photos dated August 2nd, 2008, from 12:02-12:35 a.m. They all show the inside of a bedroom, including a bed, and clothing in drawers and in a closet. In three of the photos, Mr. Williams is naked and either standing or laying in the bed, while either holding his penis or draping lingerie on his penis. The second folder contains three photos dated August 2nd, 2008, from 11:18-11:28 p.m. These photos show the inside of the occupants' bedroom. This folder also contains photos dated later that morning at 11:21 and 11:23 a.m. In one of them, Mr. Williams has photographed himself in a mirror wearing the sundress he stole with his erect penis visible in the middle of it. The third and fourth folders contain ten photos in total. These are photos Mr. Williams took of the items of the stolen clothing.

Count 23: August 2, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 72 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

45. This is the second of Russell Williams' break and enters to the residence at 72 Cosy Cove Lane. Given the timing of the photographs, it occurred immediately after the second break in to 90 Cosy Cove Lane, on August 2nd, 2008. Mr. Williams admitted that he broke into 72 Cosy Cove Lane on this date through an open door. He stole five pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two subfolders. The first folder contains seven photos dated August 3rd, 2008, from 12:04-12:35 a.m. They all show the inside of the occupants' bedroom, and focus on underwear drawers and lingerie in clothes baskets and on the bed. In two photographs, Mr. Williams is laying naked on the bed masturbating with pieces of lingerie. In two other photos, Mr. Williams is standing and looking down into a clothes basket, with his erect penis visible and draped with a piece of lingerie. The second folder contains six photos dated August 19th and 26th, 2008. These are photos Mr. Williams took of the stolen lingerie.

Count 24: August 7, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft - 52 Charles Court, Tweed

46. The third occurrence at 52 Charles Ct., Tweed, took place on August 7th, 2008, when Mr. Williams broke into the home through an open door. He stole five pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two subfolders. The first contains seven photos, four of which were taken inside the occupant's bedroom, dated August 8th, 2008 from 12:37-12:41 a.m. They show panties and bras in various parts of the room. The second folder contains 11 photos, dated August 19th-October 6th, 2008, and show, among other things, Mr. Williams wearing a pink pair of underwear underneath his own clothing.

Count 25: August 12, 2008 – Break and enter with intent to commit - 59 Charles Court, Tweed

47. The occupants of the cottage at 59 Charles Ct., Tweed, have owned it since 1988. When interviewed by police in April 2010, they were not aware of anyone having been in their cottage without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.

48. Russell Williams admitted that he broke into 59 Charles Court on August 12th, 2008, by finding a hidden key outside the cottage. He took some photos and left without taking anything. He downloaded the two photos he took inside the cottage onto his computer into a folder. The photos are taken between 12:20-12:21 a.m, on August 13th, 2008, and show the inside of a clothes drawer.

Count 26: August 13, 2008, Break and enter with intent to commit – 100 Kanata Lane, Tweed

49. The occupants of the cottage at 100 Kanata Lane, Tweed, have owned it since 1999. At the time of their interview with police in March 2010, they were not aware of anyone having been in their cottage without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.

50. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into this cottage through an open window. He looked around but did not take anything, nor did he take any photos.

Count 27: August 16, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft - 124 Charles Road, Tweed

51. On August 16th, 2008, Mr. Williams broke into the residence at 124 Charles Rd. for a second time, through an open window. He stole nine items of clothing (panties, bras and pyjamas). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two subfolders. The first contains 17 photos dated August 17th, 2008, from 12:05-12:38 a.m., which show the inside of the occupants' bedroom. These photos show family pictures on a bedside table, and clothing, including mainly lingerie, in drawers, on the floor and on a bed. The second folder contains 11 photos, dated August 19th-October 6th, 2008, of the stolen lingerie.

Count 28: August 21, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 597 Apollo Way, Ottawa

52. The occupants of 597 Apollo Way, Ottawa, live there with their four children, all over the age of 17 at the time of this offence. At the time of their interview with the police in April 2010, they were not aware of anyone having been in their home without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.

53. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 597 Apollo Way on August 21, 2008 through an open door. He stole 27 pieces of lingerie (panties, bras and a slip). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 12 photos, dated August 21, 2008, from 10:04-10:14 p.m. The photos show the inside of a bedroom, and focus on lingerie, mainly in drawers and on the floor. There are also 4 pictures of a picture collage on a wall. The second folder contains 29 photos, dated August 24th-October 28th, 2008. These photos show the items Mr. Williams stole from 597 Apollo Way.

Count 29: August 23, 2008, Break and enter, with intent to commit theft – 1714 Caminiti Crescent, Ottawa

54. The occupants of 1714 Caminiti Crescent, Ottawa, were away for the weekend of August 22nd-24th, 2008. When they returned on Sunday August 24th, they noticed that the screen was missing from a rear window. They also saw dirt inside the house at the location of that rear window. There was also a side door to the house that was open, when it was usually locked. This led them to believe that someone had broken into their home through the window and left through the side door. They reported the incident to the police, but did not report anything missing.

55. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1714 Caminiti Cres. on August 23rd, 2008, through an open window. He did not take anything. He took photographs which he downloaded onto his computer. There are three photos on his computer from this occurrence dated August 24th, 2008, from 1:05-1:07 a.m. They show a photo of a young woman in high school or college graduation wear, clothing in a drawer and the passport of one of the occupants opened up to her picture. He has also saved four screenshots of the Ottawa Police website reporting this occurrence.

Count 30: August 28, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1743 Cara Crescent, Ottawa

56. The occupants of 1743 Cara Cres., Ottawa, were away on August 28th, 2008, when they received a phone call from their neighbour to advise them that their home had been broken into. The neighbour was in their backyard to borrow a hose, when he noticed that a basement window was partially removed and broken. He then checked the house and noted that the back patio door was unlocked. The occupants returned home and called the Ottawa Police. They checked the house and, despite the fact that electronics, jewellery and alcohol were available, nothing appeared to be missing.

57. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1743 Cara Cres. on this date by breaking the basement window. He noted that breaking the window was unintentional. He stole four pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 7 photos dated August 29, 2008, from 12:44-12:48 a.m., and show clothing on a bed and in a drawer. They also show work documents as well as a passport belonging to one of the occupants in a drawer. There are also two screenshots from the Ottawa Police website reporting this occurrence. The second folder contains seven photos, dated from September 6th-October 6th, 2008. These photos show the lingerie Mr. Williams stole from this address, as well as two photos of him wearing a maroon pair of panties and a black bra, one of which is a close-up of his midsection.

Count 31: August 30, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 44 Charles Court, Tweed

58. The occupants of 44 Charles Court in Tweed, have lived at this residence since 2005. Beginning in August 2009, one of the occupants realized that she was missing a black bra and some underwear. She wasn't sure if she lost or misplaced it and therefore did not report the loss to the police.

59. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 44 Charles Ct. on August 30th, 2008, through an open door. He stole 17 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into 2 folders. The first contains 10 photos, dated August 30th, 2008, from 10:54-11:21 p.m. The photos show the inside of the home, and, specifically the inside of an underwear drawer, a bed and several family photos on the wall and on top of dressers. The second folder contains 32 photos, dated September 6th, 2008. These are photos Mr. William took of the lingerie he stole. In 15 of the photos, Mr. Williams is wearing the panties and bras, has his erect penis protruding from the panties in 10 of them, and is shown to have ejaculated in two of the photographs.

***Count 32: September 5, 2008 – Break and enter with intent to commit theft
628 Apollo Way, Ottawa***

60. The occupant of 628 Apollo Way, Ottawa, lives there with her three daughters, who were aged 11, 13 and 16 at the time of this offence. On September 5th, 2008, the occupant was at a friend's house while her children were staying with their father. At 11:09 p.m., she received a call from her alarm company, advising her that the alarm had gone off at her home. She returned home to find that the front door was unlocked and that the screen to the living room window had been cut. She called the police and, together, they went through the house but she did not notice anything damaged or missing.

61. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 628 Apollo Way on this date through a window. The alarm went off and he therefore left through that same window, without taking anything. He thought he saw a car enter the driveway as he left, but was not sure. He did not take any photos inside the house but he downloaded four screenshots from the Ottawa Police website reporting this occurrence and saved them in a subfolder on his computer.

***Count 33: October 3, 2008 – Break, enter and theft - 1723 Cara Cres.,
Ottawa***

62. The second of Russell Williams' break and enters to 1723 Cara Cres. occurred on October 3, 2008, when Mr. Williams broke into the home, again through an open window, and stole 13 pieces of lingerie (panties, bras and a slip). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 21 photos dated October 3rd, 2008, from 11:36-11:53 p.m. The photos show the inside of

the home, and, specifically, show clothing, mainly lingerie, in clothes hampers, drawers and a closet. They also show the wall in the daughter's bedroom, showing the same trophies/plaques as in the previous break and enter, a corkboard with a sign with the daughter's name on it, as well as photos of the daughter and her family and friends. The second folder contains 24 photos dated October 6th, 2008. These photos show the items Russell Williams stole from this address on October 3rd. Eight of these photos are close-ups of Mr. Williams masturbating and ejaculating with a piece of stolen underwear. The final photo only shows that piece of underwear after Mr. Williams has ejaculated into it.

Count 34: October 7, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft - 620 Simoneau Way, Ottawa

63. One day in early October 2008, the occupant of 620 Simoneau Way, Ottawa was getting ready to go to the gym when she noticed that all of her underwear was gone from the basket in the closet in which she normally keeps them. She believes she was missing approximately 2-3 bras and 14-18 pairs of panties. She called the police on October 31st, after hearing a news report of a similar underwear theft in her area. When the police arrived, they noticed that the screen to a rear window had been cut.
64. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 620 Simoneau Way on October 7th, 2008, through an open window, and stole 24 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, slip, tops and a pair of pants). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence into two folders. The first contains two photos dated October 7th, 2008, at 9:06 p.m. These photos show a bed and a clothes basket containing underwear. The second folder contains 26 photos dated October 7th, 2008, from 9:36-10:12 p.m. These photos show the clothing he stole from 620 Simoneau Way. It is unclear whether these photos were taken at the break and enter or afterward.

Count 35: October 9, 2008 – Attempted break and enter with intent to commit an offence – 553 Apollo Way, Ottawa

65. The occupants of 553 Apollo Way in Ottawa at the time of this offence lived there with their two children, including a daughter, who was 14 years old at the time. In October 2008, the occupants were out of town with their respective employment. The children remained home with an in-law. Sometime around the night of October 9th, 2008, the in-law heard noises in the basement, and went downstairs to investigate. She noticed that a window, which had previously been covered with plastic, had been ripped and was therefore open. She did not see anyone. When the occupants

returned home, they fastened the window making any further entry impossible. They did not notice anything missing or damaged. They did not report the incident to the police. Other than this incident, they are unaware of anyone ever being in their house, or trying to get into their house, without their permission.

66. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into or tried to break into 553 Apollo Way on three occasions. The first occurred on October 9th, 2008, when he broke into the house through a basement window. He quickly realized that there were two people, likely teenagers, sleeping in the beds, so he left without taking anything. He did not take any photos.

Count 36: October 23, 2008 – Attempted break and enter – 622 Stellar Street, Ottawa

67. The occupants of 622 Stellar St., Ottawa, were away on October 23rd, 2008. Their daughter came over daily to check on the house. Shortly before 11:23 p.m. on the 23rd, the alarm went off and Ottawa Police officers attended, and were met there by the daughter. Together, they searched the house and did not notice anything missing. They noticed, however, that a side door was open but did not find any further evidence. When the occupants returned home, they further noticed that the deadbolt to the side door had been tampered with and that the motion sensor light had been covered with a bucket. They did not report anything missing.

68. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he looked into 622 Stellar St. on October 22nd, 2008, but did not go in. He then returned on October 23rd, and picked two door locks to get in. The house alarm went off, so he only stayed in the home for approximately 45 seconds, and then left without taking anything. He later downloaded 3 screenshots from the OPS website of this occurrence into a folder on his computer.

Counts 37 and 38: October 24 and 25, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft times two – 652 Apollo Way, Ottawa

69. The occupants of 652 Apollo Way in Ottawa live at this address with their four children, including three girls between 12 and 21 years of age. From October 24th-October 26th, 2008, the occupants were out of town. When they returned on October 26th, they immediately noticed that someone had been in their house. They are adamant that they locked their back door when they left, but noticed that it was unlocked when they returned. They noticed that a basement window was open ½ inch and mud streaks were visible underneath it on the wall. There were also trails of leaves leading

from the basement up to the main floor. One of the daughters reported that, in her room, a photo-album of hers had been left open to a picture showing photo ID of her that she had saved. In another daughter's bedroom, numerous 4x6" pictures of her and her friends had been laid out on the floor. The occupants called the police. Officers advised them that there had been underwear thefts in the area recently, and to check their underwear drawers. All of the females in the house did so, and all, including the 12 year old daughter, reported that they were missing their underwear and other lingerie, including not only those from their drawers, but from the laundry room and from clothes piles that had been made before they left. When the 12 year old daughter logged in to her computer in her bedroom the following day, she noticed that someone had typed the word "Merci" in a Microsoft Word document and left it on her screen. That person had also opened a folder containing photos of her and her family. Neither of the two male occupants in the home reported anything missing.

70. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 652 Apollo Way on two occasions. The first occurrence happened on the evening of October 24th, 2008, when he broke in through an open door. He stole 39 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, a bathing suit, a slip and a dress). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two subfolders. The first contains 38 pictures dated October 25th, 2008, from 6:15-7:31 a.m. These pictures show the inside of the home and thus indicate that Mr. Williams was inside for at least 1 hour and 16 minutes. In two photographs, one can clearly see the 12 year old daughter's name on various certificates. Other photos show clothing, with a focus on lingerie, in various places, including a washing machine, drawers, and clothes baskets. There are also photos of family pictures on a wall. This folder contained screenshots of Ottawa Police and news websites reporting on the underwear thefts, as well as an Adobe copy of the November 1st, 2008 edition of the newspaper, "The Eastender". On page 2 of this paper, there is a story about "bizarre" break-ins involving the theft of female undergarments having occurred in the Fallingbrook area of Ottawa the previous week. The second folder contains 38 pictures dated October 25th, 2008 in the early evening showing the items he stole from 652 Apollo Way.

71. The second break in occurred the next night, on October 25th, when Russell Williams broke into the home, again through a door. He stole three pairs of panties. He also admitted to leaving the word "merci" on a computer screen and to putting pictures on the floor in one of the bedrooms. He labelled the house as belonging to the "mystery girls" though he later learned to whom the house belonged. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders, the first contains 86 photos dated October 25th, from 6:59-8:26 p.m. The photos show the inside of the home, and thus indicate that Mr. Williams

was inside for at least 1 hour and 27 minutes. There are 59 photos where Mr. Williams is holding a photo album with a gloved hand, and taking a photo of each page. The pages in the photo album show, for example, high school and university student cards of the 19 year old daughter, transit passes, and photos of her, and her friends and family. There are 9 photos where Mr. Williams has laid out 4x6" pictures of another daughter and her friends and family. There are other photos focusing on lingerie in drawers and in clothes baskets. There are two photos showing the youngest daughter's picture on a wall in her bedroom. There is a photo of a doctor's letter with her name and date of birth, thus confirming she is 12 years old. As well, there are three photos of Mr. Williams in female panties masturbating on a twin-sized bed, and one of him masturbating in a bathroom. Also within this folder, there is also the same edition of the "Eastender" referred to in the previous occurrence and many of the same website screenshots reporting on underwear thefts. Another folder contains three photos of women's panties, dated October 26th, 2008.

Count 39: October 25, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 621 Wilkie Drive, Ottawa

72. This break and enter occurred shortly after the previous break and enter to 652 Apollo Way. The occupant of 621 Wilkie Dr., Ottawa, lives there with her 2 children, including her then 12 year old daughter. On the evening of October 25th, 2008, she was out and her children were with their father. When she returned home, she noticed that the fence door to her backyard was open. In the house, she noticed that there were muddy footprints near a window in the dining room (it had been raining). The screen to that window was missing. She searched her house quickly but did not immediately notice anything missing. After some prompting by a friend, she contacted the Ottawa Police, who asked her if any of her lingerie was missing. She checked her room, and noticed that much of her lingerie and a red satin robe were missing. She also checked her daughter's room, and noticed that much of her underwear was gone. Her son's room was untouched. She was able to give the police a detailed list of what was missing. The police arrived, but the muddy footprints had been washed away by the rain. They found the screen to the dining room window in a hedge in the backyard.
73. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 621 Wilkie Dr. twice on October 25th, 2008, through windows. On the 1st occasion, he stole 77 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, a bathing suit, a slip and a camisole). On the 2nd occasion, he stole 27 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, a slip, a top and a house coat). He downloaded the pictures he took of these occurrences into four subfolders. The first folder contains six photos dated October 25th, 2008, from 10:59-11:06 p.m. These photos

show the inside of two different bedrooms. Specifically, the photos focus on lingerie in drawers and on the beds. The second folder contains 10 photos dated October 26th, 2008, from 12:47-1:07 a.m. These photos show various parts of the house, including one of the bedrooms seen in the other folder. The photos focus on undergarments in drawers, in clothes baskets, in a closet and on a bed. There is also one photo of a red satin-looking robe hanging on the back of a door. The other two folders contain various screenshots of the Ottawa Police and news websites reporting on underwear thefts. They also contain the same November 1st, 2008, edition of the "Eastender" newspaper which mentions the underwear thefts. They also contain a total of 94 photos dated later in the day on October 26th, 2008. These photos show the items Mr. Williams stole from 621 Wilkie Dr. laid out both individually and collectively.

Count 40: November 4, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 496 Minnie Avenue, Tweed

74. At the time of their interview with police in March 2010, the occupants of 496 Minnie Ave., Tweed, had lived at this address for 21 years. In early November 2009, they were away, but their daughter stayed home. Upon their return, they noticed that the basement and bathroom windows had been pushed out, and that there was a footprint on a tarp used to cover the patio furniture. They did not notice anything missing and therefore did not report the incident to the police. They were otherwise unaware of anyone ever having been in their home without their permission, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.
75. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 496 Minnie Ave. on two occasions. The first occurred on November 4th, 2008. He broke into the home through an open window and stole 13 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, a dress, a top, a bathing suit and pyjama bottoms). He downloaded photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 13 photos dated November 5, 2008, from 12:08-12:33 a.m. They show the inside of 2 bedrooms, and specifically, show beds, closets, underwear drawers and family pictures, including a graduation photo of the daughter on top of a dresser and a shelf. The second folder contains 17 photos dated November 11, 2008, which show the items of clothing Mr. Williams stole from 496 Minnie Ave., laid out on a flat surface. In the final 3 photos, Mr. Williams is standing naked from the waist down.

Count 41: November 12, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1735 Cara Crescent, Ottawa

76. During the time period of early-mid November 2008, the occupants of 1735 Cara Cres., Ottawa, did not notice anything suggesting that their home had been broken into.
77. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1735 Cara Cres. on November 12th, 2008, through an open window. He stole 11 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded photos of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains five photos dated November 12, 2008, from 8:57-9:00 p.m. These photos show the inside of the occupants' bedroom, and focus on lingerie in drawers and on the floor. The second folder contains 11 photos dated November 20th, 2008, and show the lingerie Mr. Williams stole from this address.

Count 42: November 20, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1648 Canemore Crescent, Ottawa

78. At the time of this offence, the occupants of 1648 Canemore Crescent, Ottawa, lived there with their 2 children, including their then 15 year old daughter. In a statement to the police in April 2010, the daughter advised that she came home one afternoon in November 2008, and noticed that she was missing a bra, several pairs of underwear and a bathing suit from a drawer in her bedroom. They did not report the incident to police, however, because they felt it could have been a prank pulled by some of her step-siblings.
79. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1648 Canemore Cres. on November 20th, 2008, through an open door, and stole 22 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, a bathing and a night shirt). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into four folders. The first two folders contain a total of 10 photos dated November 20th, 2008, from 10:34-11:19 p.m. The photos show the inside of the home, and specifically, an underwear drawer, a bed, a fridge with two photos of a young boy and girl on it, a closet and a bedside table. The other two folders contain a total of 91 pictures. The first 21 pictures show the pieces of clothing he stole from the daughter. One of the pairs of underwear has what appears to be a blood stain. The final 70 photos are close-up photos of Mr. Williams wearing, licking or kissing the stained portion of this pair of underwear. The final 12 photos in this sequence show Mr. Williams masturbating and ejaculating onto that stain.

Count 43: December 5, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 616 Simoneau Way, Ottawa

80. On December 5, 2008, Mr. Williams broke into the residence at 616 Simoneau Way for a 2nd time through an open window, and stole 42 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, pyjamas, a bathing suit and a top). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence into three folders. The first contains 27 photos dated December 6th, 2008, from 12:32-1:01 a.m. These photos show the inside of what appear to be two bedrooms, including that of two young girls which were depicted in the photos from his previous break and enter to this residence. The photos show the beds in the rooms as well clothing, mainly underwear, in drawers, clothes baskets and closets. There is also one photo of a frame containing seven photos of young girls, which is different from either of those seen in the previous occurrence. The other two folders contain 82 photos dated December 6th, 2008 from 10:06-11:52 a.m. at a different location. Twenty-eight of these photos are close-ups of Mr. Williams' midsection or of him masturbating, the final two show him having ejaculated. The remaining photos are of the clothing he stole from 616 Simoneau Way.

Count 44: December 10, 2008 – Break, enter and commit theft – 615 Wilkie Drive, Ottawa

81. The occupant of 615 Wilkie Dr., Ottawa, was on vacation on December 10th, 2008. His girlfriend, who stays at his house occasionally and keeps many personal belongings there, was with him. The occupant's brother was watching the house. On December 10th, the occupant received a call from his brother reporting that the house had been broken into. The police attended on December 11th, and on several days after that, to conduct an investigation. They noticed footprints in the snow in the backyard, leading to the back patio door. They noticed that the patio door was unlocked, and that it and the screen had been pushed open. They further noticed that a kitchen window was unlocked and that the screen had been pushed in. The police found fingerprints on the computer keyboard, but a forensic examination of that computer indicated that it had not been used since the occupant left for vacation. When the occupant returned on December 14th, he noticed damage to various window locks on the main floor and to the back patio door. His girlfriend noticed that a significant amount of her lingerie and some of their sex toys were missing. They provided the police with a detailed description of what was missing.

82. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 615 Wilkie Dr. on December 10th, 2008, through a window. He stole twenty pieces of clothing (panties, bras and a skirt) and seven sex toys. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into three folders.

The first contains 16 photos dated December 11th, 2008, from 12:38-12:54 a.m. These photos show the inside of a bedroom, and focus on clothing (including lingerie) inside drawers and a closet, and laid out by Mr. Williams, along with the sex toys, on the floor. There are also photos of two screenshots from the Ottawa Police website dated December 15th and 20th, 2008, reporting on this break and enter. The second folder contains 20 photos dated December 11th, 2008 from 9:03-9:20 p.m. These pictures show the items he stole from 615 Wilkie Dr.. The final folder contains 17 photos dated January 14th, 2009, of Mr. Williams masturbating into a green sex toy that he stole from 615 Wilkie Dr.

Counts 45 and 46: January 1 and 2, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft two times – 1749 Cara Crescent, Ottawa

83. The occupants of 1749 Cara Cres., Ottawa, live at this address with their three children, including a daughter who was 15 years old at the time of these offences. From December 29th, 2008 to January 2nd, 2009, the occupants were out of town. When they returned, their daughter noticed that approximately 50 pairs of underwear, dresses, bathing suits, tank tops and many of her photos, including head-shots done for a modelling agency, were missing. She was also missing a piece of paper containing lip-gloss lip prints. She noted that items in her room, such as paintings, had been altered or moved. They called the Ottawa Police who arrived and examined the house. Among the items the police found was a sample of what the police described as being consistent with dried semen, from the top of the dresser from which the daughter's undergarments had been stolen. The sample was submitted to the Centre for Forensic Sciences (C.F.S.), however, was deemed not suitable for D.N.A. comparison analysis. Their daughter was able to provide the police with a detailed description of the items she was missing. No one else in the house reported that anything was missing. In the time period following the break and enters, their daughter was too scared to sleep in her bedroom, and thus slept in the spare room with her dog.

84. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1749 Cara Cres. through open windows on consecutive nights, from December 31st, 2008 to January 1st, 2009. On December 31st, he stole 68 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, bathing suits and a top). On his computer record, he labelled this entry "HNY" for Happy New Years. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 35 photos, dated January 1st, 2009, from 12:29-12:57 a.m. The photos appear to show two different bedrooms. There are photos of clothing on a bed, in drawers, in closets and on the floor. There are photos of the 15 year old daughter's headshots and the lip-gloss lip prints page, as well as a wedding picture on top of a dresser. In one photo, Mr.

Williams is visible inside a bedroom taking a picture into a mirror. He is dressed in jeans, a shirt and large winter boots. The second folder contains 63 pictures dated January 3rd, 2009. These photos show the clothing Mr. Williams stole from this address.

85. During the second break and enter on January 1st, 2009, Mr. Williams stole eight pieces of clothing (dresses and a top). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 16 photos dated January 2nd, 2009, from 12:33-1:11 a.m. These pictures show the inside of the 15 year old daughter's bedroom. In all but one of these photos, Mr. Williams is either naked or wearing the daughter's clothing. In some of the photos he is wearing her clothing and holding his penis, which is erect in some of the photos. In one photo he is holding a make-up brush to his penis. The second folder contains eight photos dated January 3, 2009. These photos show the clothing he took.

86. When the police searched Mr. Williams' Edison Avenue in Ottawa home on February 13th, 2010 after his arrest, they found a box in the basement, containing the daughter's head-shot photos and the piece of paper containing her lip-gloss lip prints.

Count 47: January 17, 2009 – Attempted break and enter with intent – 561 Apollo Way, Ottawa

87. In January 2009, the occupants of 561 Apollo Way, Ottawa, were away on their honeymoon. When they returned, they noticed that their back patio door no longer opened and shut properly. They did not notice anything missing from the house and thus did not report the matter to police.

88. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he tried to break into 561 Apollo Way on this occasion through a door, but it was locked. He therefore did not get in, nor did he take any pictures.

Count 48: January 17, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1646 Orford Crescent, Ottawa

89. At the time of their interview with police in April 2010, the occupants of 1646 Orford Cres., Ottawa, stated that they were not aware of anyone ever having been in their home without their permission nor of anything missing from their home.

90. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into this home on January 17th, 2009, through an open door. He stole 14 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains six

photos, dated January 18th, 2009, from 2:33-2:36 a.m. These photos show the inside of the home, and, specifically, clothing, mainly lingerie, inside a closet, in drawers and on the floor. The second folder contains 14 photos dated January 19th, 2009, and show the lingerie he stole from 1646 Orford Cres.

Count 49: February 14, 2009 – Attempted break and enter with intent – 1652 Canemore Crescent, Ottawa

91. The occupants of 1652 Canemore Cres., Ottawa, live at this address with their 2 infant boys. They were out of town on February 14th, 2009, when they got a call from their alarm company, advising them that the alarm had gone off at their home because the basement window had been tampered with. The occupants called their neighbour, who went to the house and noticed that the window had been removed. When they returned, they noticed that there were footprints leading to their side fence, where there was some broken lattice. It did not appear as though anyone actually entered the home and they did not notice anything missing. The occupants called the police.

92. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he attended 1652 Canemore Cres. on this date and slid the basement window off in an attempt to break into the house. However, the alarm went off as soon as he did so and he left immediately without entering the home.

Counts 50 and 51: March 14 and 15, 2009 – Two counts of Attempt Break and enter with intent – 553 Apollo Way, Ottawa

93. These were the second and third attempts to break and enter the residence at 553 Apollo Way. Russell Williams attempted to break in to this residence on the evenings of both March 14th and 15th, 2009, through the same basement window he had entered on October 9th, 2008. As a result of the occupant having fastened the window securely, Mr. Williams was unsuccessful.

Count 52: April 12, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1684 Canemore Crescent, Ottawa

94. The occupant of 1684 Canemore Cres., Ottawa, lives at this address with her daughter (who was 18 years old at the time of this offence), as well as her three sons. On Easter weekend 2009 (April 10th-13th), the occupant and her daughter were away, but her sons were home. They were out of the house on Sunday (April 12th) from 4:00-10:30 p.m. When they

returned, one of the boys went to their sister's room to feed her pet and noticed that a drawer had been pulled out. Other than that, they did not find anything suspicious. When the daughter returned on April 13th, she found that her underwear drawer had been emptied. They called police, and she provided a detailed account of the lingerie she was missing.

95. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1684 Canemore Cres. on this date through an open door, and stole 48 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains three photos, two of which are dated April 12th, 2009, from 9:18-9:19 p.m. They show the inside of the daughter's bedroom and show a closeup of her underwear drawer and her bed. This folder also contained a 148-page monthly crime report downloaded from the Ottawa Police website as well as a screenshot of the Ottawa Police website reporting on this occurrence. The next folder (divided into 2 subfolders) contains 77 photos dated from April 15th-April 28th, 2009. The first 18 photos show Mr. Williams wearing the various pieces of lingerie he stole from the occupant's daughter, and include eight close-ups of his penis either in his hand or simply visible. The final 59 photos show the lingerie he stole from this address.

Count 53: April 17, 2009 – Attempt Break and enter with intent - 7 Charles Court, Tweed.

96. This was the final attempt to break in to the residence at 7 Charles Ct., Tweed. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that on April 17, 2009, he attempted to pick the lock of 7 Charles Ct., but was unsuccessful. He therefore left without entering the home.

Count 54: April 18, 2009 – Break, enter and theft - 52 Charles Court, Tweed,

97. The fourth break and enter to the residence at 52 Charles Ct., Tweed, was on April 18th, 2009. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 52 Charles Ct., through an open door. He stole two pairs of panties. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 14 photos, 9 of which are dated April 18th from 11:28-11:37 p.m. These photos show the inside of the occupants' bedroom, and include photos of the bed, a lingerie drawer, a night table drawer with a sex toy displayed, and a clothes basket. Several photos clearly show that Mr. Williams has taken a piece of lingerie and placed it on the ground to photograph. There's also a picture of a framed picture of the female occupant and an older woman on a dresser. The second folder contains six photos, dated April 26th. In them, Mr. Williams is wearing only the underwear he stole on April 18th. They show

close-ups of his midsection, with him either masturbating with a piece of lingerie or displaying his penis.

Count 55: April 19, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft – 490 Minnie Avenue, Tweed

98. At the time of their interviews with police in March 2010, the occupants of 490 Minnie Ave., Tweed, were unaware of anyone having been in their home without their permission, nor of anything missing. Their 21 year old daughter, however, who stays there periodically and kept some clothes in a bedroom, noted that she was missing some bras, underwear and pyjamas. She could not be sure of when they went missing because she had not been there for some time.

99. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 490 Minnie Ave. on April 18th, 2009, through an open window. From the timing of the photographs, he entered this residence shortly after the previous break-in at 52 Charles Ct. (count 54). He took 12 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras) from what he termed “the daughter’s bedroom” and left. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 56 photos. The first 29 photos are dated April 19th, 2009, between 1:36-3:22 a.m. and show the inside of 2 bedrooms. Mr. Williams was therefore inside 490 Minnie Ave. for at least 2 hours 46 minutes. The photos show lingerie in drawers and on a bed, which he has set out on display for photographing. He has also taken a photo of a framed picture of a young girl on a bedside table. In the final 17 photos taken inside the home, Mr. Williams is either posing on a bed naked with underwear and a stuffed animal laid out around him and lying on his chest, or has draped his erect penis in lingerie and taken photos of his penis. The next folder contains 10 photos dated April 26th, 2009. They show the lingerie stolen from 490 Minnie Ave. laid out on a flat surface as well as close-ups of Mr. Williams’ midsection while he is wearing the underwear he stole. His erect penis is visible in seven of the photos.

Count 56: May 9, 2009 – Break, enter and theft – 52 Charles Court, Tweed,

100. In the fifth break and enter to 52 Charles Ct., on May 9th, 2009, Mr. Williams broke in through an open door, and stole a pair of panties. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer. There are 14 photos dated May 9th-10th, 2009, from 11:47 p.m.-12:20 a.m. of the inside of the occupants’ bedroom. The photos show, among other things, the female occupant’s university degree on a wall, the inside of her lingerie drawer, of a sex toy, and a portrait of her on the wall. Eight of the pictures show Mr. Williams inside her bedroom, either

naked or wearing only a pair of panties, and either masturbating or showing his penis, as well as applying lubricant to his penis.

Counts 57, 58 and 59: May 28, June 2 and June 4, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft x2 and Attempted break and enter – 591 Simoneau Way, Ottawa

101. When interviewed by police in April 2010, the occupants of 591 Simoneau Way, Ottawa, were unaware of anyone having broken into their home nor of anything missing from their home.
102. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he either broke into or tried to break into 591 Simoneau Way on three occasions. The first occurred on May 28th, 2009, when he broke into the home through an open window. He quickly noticed that the occupants' son had entered the driveway, and he therefore left without taking anything.
103. The second occurrence happened on June 2nd, 2009, when he broke into 591 Simoneau Way through an open window and stole 28 pieces of lingerie (panties, bras and a camisole). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into five folders. The first contains four photos dated June 2nd, 2009, from 10:54-10:58 p.m. These photos show the inside of a bedroom, and specifically, pieces of lingerie inside two drawers and then laid out by Mr. Williams on the floor. The other four folders contain a total of 69 photos dated from June 2nd-24th, 2009. 15 of the photos are close-ups of Mr. Williams' midsection while he is wearing panties that he stole from this address. In the photos, Mr. Williams' is either showing his penis or masturbating.
104. The final occurrence happened two nights later, on June 4th, 2009, when Mr. Williams broke into the home through an open window and stole 21 pieces of lingerie (panties, bras and a camisole). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into four subfolders, most of which are identical or overlap with photos he took of the previous occurrence. However, there are 16 pictures dated June 4th, 2009, from 11:15-11:59 p.m. These pictures show the inside of the same bedroom as in the previous occurrence. They show clothing, mainly lingerie, inside a drawer and a closet, and also laid out by Mr. Williams on the floor and the bed. Furthermore, there are two family and wedding pictures on a shelf. There is also one photo laid out on the bed showing a photo of a group of teenaged kids on a beach. Finally, there are four photos of Mr. Williams naked. In two of them, he is lying on the bed and masturbating with lingerie piled in front of him. The other two photos are close-ups of his erect penis draped with a piece of lingerie.

Count 60: June 5, 2009 – Attempted break and enter with intent – 1644 Orford Crescent, Ottawa

105. When contacted by police in April 2010, the occupants of 1644 Orford Cres., Ottawa, at the time of this offence advised them that they had never noticed anything suspicious in or around their home, nor had they ever noticed anything missing.
106. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that, on June 5th, 2009, he removed the basement window of 1644 Orford Cres., but did not enter because the owners had arrived at home. He left and advised that the owners did not see him.

Count 61: June 19, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft – 1702 Cara Crescent, Ottawa

107. The occupant of 1702 Cara Cres., Ottawa, lives at this address with his 24 year old daughter. In her statement to the police on June 21st, 2009, the daughter advised the police that she and her father were out of the house from June 18th-June 20th. Before leaving, she ensured that a wooden stick was lodged in the back patio door to keep it secure. She returned home late on June 20th, and on the morning of June 21st noticed that much of her underwear drawer had been emptied, and that she was missing: bras and panties from a clean clothes pile in the laundry room; dirty underwear, dresses and bathing suits from her closet; two pairs of panties from a Victoria's Secret bag that had been on her bed as well as other clothing items that had been in various parts of her room. She provided a detailed description to the police of what exactly was missing. She also noticed that some of her identification had been laid out on a dresser in the spare room, her laptop had been opened and that some of the laundry she had left folded, was now unfolded. She further advised that she had some expensive jewellery on her dresser that, surprisingly to her, had not been taken. The occupant reported that the wooden stick to the back patio door had been removed, and that the screen to a basement window was missing and the frame had been pushed in.
108. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 1702 Cara Cres. on June 19th, 2009, through an open window and stole 186 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, bathing suits, dresses, a slip, etc). He knew this was the home of the occupant's daughter. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into three folders. The first contains 77 photos dated June 20th, 2009, from 1:47-4:20 a.m. They predominantly show the inside of the daughter's bedroom,

meaning he was in the home for at least 2 hours and 33 minutes. These photos show, for example:

- a. 13 photos of Mr. Williams either naked or wearing one of the daughter's tops, and masturbating on her bed. Seven of these photos are close-ups of his erect penis;
- b. Numerous photos of her clothing, mainly her undergarments, in drawers, on the bed, in the closet, on the floor, or in the laundry room. In some of the photos vast quantities of clothing have been painstakingly laid out for the photographs;
- c. a wall with a sign with the daughter's name on it; and,
- d. a letter from the Royal Bank addressed to the daughter.

109. The next folder contains 207 photos dated June 20th-21st, 2009. These photos show the pieces of clothing Mr. Williams stole from the daughter. The photos are divided into subfolders that are individually labelled as: "Basement laundry"; "Bedroom"; "Bedroom laundry"; "Spare room" and "The [daughter's] Collection". The first subfolder contains 31 photos dated June 21st, 2009. They show Mr. Williams wearing a pink top and several of the stolen pairs of panties. In these photos, he is posing, masturbating and ejaculating. All but three of the photos are close-ups of his penis.

110. Mr. Williams saved several further items of significance onto his computer in the main subfolder pertaining to this occurrence, including:

- A letter labelled "[daughter's name].doc", which reads:

"Beautiful [daughter]. I'm sorry I took these because I am sentimental to. Don't worry because I didn't mess with them. Also I am sure you know your beautiful but trust me your pussy smells fucking awesome! I should know because I been doing this for awhile. But I am going to stop because my moms will fucking kill me if I get caught. She is pretty sure I can be something. Besides your place was kinda like the motherload and I really like that I have a bunch of undies you put on just after you got fucked. I started this with a chick I knew from high school called ... who lives down the road from you. I thought it would be cool to have some of her undies. It seems right that I finish with a special chick like you. If you decide to call the cops tell them that I am sorry for the trouble and they won't here from me again. Now that I know all about you I think it might be cool to meet you. Maybe younger guys don't turn you on but I think we could be good together. To me teenage chicks are

impressed to easy. I guess I would like to be with somebody more experienced. You guys really need to clean out the bath in the basement. It is some gnarly. I hope what I did ain't pissed you off to much.

Ps Since I sorta feel guilty about wasting the cops time these are the places I hit, so they can close there books.”
[sic]

111. At the end of the letter, Russell Williams then goes on to list all of the Ottawa break and enters he had committed from May 9, 2008 until the break and enter to 1702 Cara. Cres. on June 19th. That list corresponds exactly to the Ottawa offences he later confessed to having committed up to that point. There is no indication he ever gave the daughter a copy of this letter.
112. His computer also revealed a saved screenshot of the daughter's Facebook page and five screenshots of the Ottawa Police website reporting this occurrence.

Count 62: July 10, 2009 – Break, Enter and commit theft - 52 Charles Court, Tweed

109. The 6th of Russell Williams' break and enter offences to the residence at 52 Charles Ct. occurred on July 10th, 2009. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that, at approximately 1:30 a.m. on July 11, 2009 he stood in the occupants' backyard for approximately 30 minutes and watched the female occupant go into the shower. He then stripped down, and broke into her home while naked, leaving his clothes outside. He went down the hall, passed the bathroom where she was showering, and went into her bedroom. He stole a pair of her underwear and left. No one else was home. Mr. Williams agreed with Det. Sgt. Smyth's suggestion that this act was an indication that his behaviour was escalating. He admitted that, by this point, he wanted to take more risks. He did not take any photos at the house, but did later take a photo of the black thong he stole and downloaded it into a folder. In his examination of Mr. Williams' computer, Det. Sgt. Falconer of the O.P.P. E-Crimes unit found a document in which Mr. Williams wrote about this occurrence. It states:

“38/67 – on naked walk from back forty – after having watched [the occupant] for 30 mins., or so, and confident that she was home alone, I entered her house naked just after she got into the shower

(approx 0140) – very tempting to take her panties/bra from bathroom – decided it would be entirely obvious that someone was in the house while she was in the shower – took panties from panty drawer instead...”

When confronted with this document by Det. Sgt. Smyth, Mr. Williams admitted that he wrote it and that it pertained to this particular occurrence. He noted that he had forgotten about it and that is why it was not filed in the same subfolder as the one photo he took of the black thong.

Count 63: July 21, 2009 – Attempt break and enter with intent – 38 Cosy Cove, Tweed

110. This was the third attempt to break and enter the residence at 38 Cosy Cove Ln. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he tried to break into this address on this date but was unsuccessful.

Count 64: July 24, 2009 – Break and enter with intent to commit theft – 700 Sulphide Road, Tweed

111. 700 Sulphide Rd. is a cottage. The occupants of the cottage enlist their neighbours to watch over the cottage when they are not there. At some point, the neighbours noticed that a screen might have been damaged, but were not sure if it was caused by the wind. Other than that, neither occupant has noticed any sign of someone being in the cottage without permission, nor have they noticed anything missing.

112. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 700 Sulphide Rd. through an open window. He said that an older couple lived there and that he did not take anything. He took six photos of the cottage and downloaded them onto his computer into a folder. They are dated July 24th, 2009, from 3:42-3:44 a.m., and show the inside of a bedroom and bathroom.

Counts 65 and 66: July 25 and 26, 2009 – 2 counts of Break, enter and commit theft – 693 Mathieu Way, Ottawa

113. The occupants of 693 Mathieu Way, Ottawa, live at this address with their three daughters, who were aged 21, 18, and 14 at the time of these offences. From July 25-27, 2009, the family was away on a trip. When they returned, the occupants noticed that the screen on a rear window had been ripped off and put on the ground, and that the window had

been forced open. The 18 year old daughter noticed that a pile of laundry on her bed had been pushed onto the floor. Apart from these 2 observations, the occupants did not notice anything missing. They therefore did not report the incident to the police.

114. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 693 Mathieu Way, Ottawa, on consecutive nights, from July 25th to 26th, 2009. He also admitted that he went back for a 3rd time on July 27th, but noticed that the family had come home. He therefore did not try to re-enter the home. On July 25th, he broke into the home through an open window, and stole 36 pieces of clothing (panties, bras and a bathing suit). He downloaded the photos of this occurrence onto his computer into four folders. The first contains 17 photos dated July 26th, 2009, from 12:26-12:48 a.m. These photos show two bedrooms, one of which contains bunk-beds. Specifically, the photos show clothing, with a focus on undergarments, in drawers, clothes baskets and on a bed. One photo also shows a framed picture of a group of young teenaged girls on top of a dresser. The other three folders contain 113 photos in total, dated July 27th when he is clearly not in the home. There are 47 photos of Mr. Williams wearing the clothing he stole from 693 Mathieu Way, including 22 of him masturbating, and the last three which show he has ejaculated. There are also numerous photos of the clothing he stole from both break ins. The framed photo of young teenaged girls is visible in five of them, thus he stole this framed photo as well.
115. On July 26th, Mr. Williams broke into 693 Mathieu Way through an open door and stole 16 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, a bathing suit, a dress, a top and pyjamas). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into four folders, three of which overlap with the pictures from the previous night's break-in. The first folder contains 33 pictures, dated July 26th-27th, 2009, from 11:11 p.m.-12:24 a.m. These pictures show the inside of the bedroom with the bunk-beds, meaning he was in the home on this occasion for at least 1 hour and 13 minutes. In one photo, you can see a CD with one of the occupant's name written on it in red marker. Other photos focus on clothing within the room, usually undergarments, as well as on the dresser and the desk, and their respective contents. In two photographs, Mr. Williams has removed what appears to be a female's elementary school graduation picture, and placed it in clear view on a desk. Notably, there are seven photos where Mr. Williams is lying naked on a bed, including 6 on the lower bunk-bed, and masturbating near a pile of clothing he has placed near him. Also, there are three close-up photos of Mr. Williams' erect penis as he is standing beside the same lower bunk-bed. There are also three photos of Mr. Williams standing naked in a bathroom masturbating, two of which are close-ups of his erect penis. The remaining folders contain a total of 95 photos, and are either identical or

similar to those described in the folders from the previous (July 25th) occurrence.

Count 67: August 1, 2009 – Attempted break and enter with intent – 128 Charles Road, Tweed

116. The occupants of 128 Charles Rd., Tweed, live at this address with their children, including their daughter, who was 14 years old at the time of this offence. When interviewed by police in March, 2010, the occupants were not aware of anyone ever having been in their house without their permission, nor were they aware of anything missing.
117. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that 128 Charles Rd. was a house he really wanted to get into. He thought a girl lived there, who was approximately 16-17 years old. As noted above, she was 14 years of age at the time of this break in. On August 1st, 2009, he tried to break into this house by removing the screen to a window. He told Det. Sgt. Smyth, however, that it was late and dogs were barking, so he replaced the screen without entering.

Count 68: August 2, 2009 – Break and enter with intent - 72 Cosy Cove Tweed

118. This was the third and final break and enter by Russell Williams to 72 Cosy Cove Lane. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that, while naked, he broke into 72 Cosy Cove Lane on August 2, 2009, but did not take anything and did not take any photos.

Counts 69, 70 and 71: August 27, 28 and 29, 2009 – Three counts of Break, enter and theft - 52 Charles Court, Tweed

119. The 7th break and enter to the residence at 52 Charles Ct. occurred on August 27th, 2009, when Russell Williams broke into the home through an open door. However, he noticed a man sleeping in the bedroom and assumed it was the husband, so he left without taking anything. The male did not wake up.
120. The 8th and 9th break and enters to this address occurred on the two subsequent nights, August 28th and 29th, 2009. Russell Williams admitted that he broke into 52 Charles Ct. on these two occasions through an open door and stole a total of six pieces of lingerie (panties, bras and camisoles). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into various folders. The first contains 15

photos dated August 29th, 2009, from 12:46-1:07 a.m. The photos show the inside of the bedroom and are similar to those seen in previous occurrences, with the usual focus on lingerie. The next folder contains 22 photos dated August 29th-30th, 2009, from 11:59 p.m.-12:50 a.m. These photos show the inside of the bedroom, meaning he was inside the home for at least 51 minutes. The photos focus on lingerie in drawers and on the floor, and sex toys. There are 10 photos of Mr. Williams in the bedroom or bathroom, where he is either completely naked and pointing his penis towards a lingerie drawer or hanging underwear off of his erect penis, wearing lingerie with his penis visible, or standing in front of a mirror wearing what looks like a female bathing suit and exposing his penis. The final four of these photos are of Mr. Williams wearing only a bra and female underwear, standing in front of the bathroom mirror exposing his penis and masturbating. The last two subfolders contain pictures of the lingerie he stole during this break and enter, dated later in the day on August 29th, 2009. In four of them, Mr. Williams is wearing the stolen underwear, bra and camisole, and exposing his penis.

Count 72: September 1, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft - 128 Charles Rd., Tweed

121. On September 1st, 2009, Russell Williams succeeded in breaking into the residence at 128 Charles Rd., Tweed through an open door. He stole five pieces of lingerie (panties, bras and a camisole). He then left the house. He did not leave the property, however. Rather, he stayed outside the house to try and see the 14 year old daughter when she came home. While waiting, he also stripped naked and masturbated. Ultimately, when the girl arrived home, Mr. Williams did not re-enter the house.
122. Russell Williams was not initially forthcoming to Det. Sgt. Smyth with this information. Det. Sgt. Jim Falconer, of the O.P.P. E-Crimes unit, who, as noted above, analyzed Mr. Williams' computer after his arrest, found a document hidden within Mr. Williams' complex file folder system on his computer hard drives which stated the following:

"I've been wanting to get into [daughter's] bedroom for a long time. Had screen out and window open a few weeks ago, but that time it was quite late and the dogs were barking in the basement. This time, the back porch door was open. After I'd collected what I'd wanted I'd stripped naked in the back yard. I was jerking off, preparing to go back in and get a shot lying on [daughter's] sheets, when her Dad came home ([daughter] followed within 10 mins). While I was in her room, I took the liberty of moving her guitar

slightly, so I could see her bed from outside (little ladder lying there...). I watched her lie down and, within 10 mins, turn out the light. Unfortunately, I didn't catch her changing – maybe tomorrow night...in bed ...”

123. When confronted with this note, Mr. Williams admitted that he wrote it in relation to this occurrence. He said he had forgotten the note's contents. Det. Sgt. Smyth asked Mr. Williams what he was preparing to do to the daughter had her father not come home. Apart from denying that he had a desire to re-enter the home, Mr. Williams refused to answer the question.
124. Mr. Williams downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains nine photos dated September 1st, 2009, from 10:21-10:29 p.m. These photos show the inside of the 14 year old daughter's bedroom and include shots of the bed, the dresser with family pictures on it and the inside of an underwear drawer. There is also one photo in which you can see a guitar. The second folder contains nine photos, dated September 2nd, 2009. These are photos Mr. Williams took of the daughter's clothing that he stole from the home and include four photos where Mr. Williams is wearing them and staring into a mirror while taking photos.

Counts 73 and 74 – September 17, 2009 – Sexual assault on Jane Doe, Forcible confinement of Jane Doe

Background:

125. As of September 17th, 2009, Ms. Jane Doe was 20 years old and lived at XXXXX Rd., Tweed, with her boyfriend Mr. XXXX and her then 8 week old daughter. Her boyfriend worked out of town during the week, and she was therefore usually alone with her baby during the week. They had only lived at this residence for a short time.
126. Prior to September 17th, 2009, Ms. Jane Doe had never met Russell Williams.

Evidence of Jane Doe:

127. On September 16th, 2009, Ms. Jane Doe returned home from her mother's house between 9:30-10:00 p.m. Mr. XXXX was working out of town. She locked her front door, but did not check the back patio door, believing it to be locked after having checked it the previous night. At 11:00 p.m., with her daughter asleep, Ms. Jane Doe then went to sleep in her own bedroom wearing a tank top and pyjama pants.

128. Ms. Jane Doe was awakened by someone holding down her head. She thought she was dreaming. The person, unknown to Ms. Jane Doe at the time, was Russell Williams. He remained holding her head down for some time, causing Ms. Jane Doe to ask if she was going to be killed. Mr. Williams told her no, but would not disclose his intentions. She could not say how long he stayed like this, but she estimates it was approximately 30 minutes, although she said it seemed like forever. Ms. Jane Doe advised he was very strong.
129. Mr. Williams told her it was 1:00 a.m. He asked her how long she had lived at that address and where the father of her child was. Ms. Jane Doe responded that she had lived there for a month, but refused to answer the second question.
130. Mr. Williams then manipulated her to the side of the bed, sat on her buttocks, and put his hands on her back. He then struck her very hard three times on her head and told her to be quiet. Mr. Williams was also adamant that Ms. Jane Doe not see his face.
131. At one point, Ms. Jane Doe told him that he did not seem like the type of person that would do something like this. After this, Mr. Williams seemed to get “nicer”.
132. Mr. Williams then tried to tie up her hands, but had little success. He tried using a baby blanket, a receiving blanket and a pillow case, but was initially unsuccessful. Ultimately, he tied her hands with a pillow case shaped into ties, and led her to the living room. He repeatedly uttered that he needed control over her to allow him to walk her to another room.
133. Ms. Jane Doe heard him take something from a bag, and they returned to her bedroom. She asked what was happening, to which Mr. Williams responded that, “you’ll see”. He told her he was not going to hurt her.
134. At one point, Ms. Jane Doe told Mr. Williams that she was fat, having just had a baby. Her belief was that, hopefully, Mr. Williams would find her unattractive and therefore leave. Mr. Williams, however, told her she was perfect and sweet.
135. Upon their return to her bedroom, Mr. Williams put a pillow case over her head. This ultimately made her claustrophobic, so Mr. Williams used it as a blindfold.
136. He then slid down the right side of her tank top, revealing her right breast. He took a photograph of her. He then slid down the whole tank top, and took another photograph of her breasts. He also repeatedly touched her breasts.

137. Next, he had her take her pants off, and took more photographs of her. He had her spread her legs, and took a photograph of her vaginal area. This made Ms. Jane Doe very upset, but Mr. Williams said he was not going to do anything further and that he was going to leave after that.
138. Mr. Williams then left the room, leaving Ms. Jane Doe alone in her bedroom. She thought he was in her daughter's room, but she was not sure. She did not know what he was doing.
139. She then heard Mr. Williams return and seemingly open her drawers. She could not be sure, but thought he was looking for her underwear. He also took all the sheets off of her bed. She later noted that she was missing bras and underwear.
140. Mr. Williams had Ms. Jane Doe stand up. He touched her breasts again, and put his face up against hers. He asked her her daughter's age.
141. Finally, he told her to count to 300. She got to 70 and stopped, upon which Mr. Williams told her to keep going. She got to 200 and yelled out, but did not hear anything in return. She undid her blindfold and called various people, ultimately speaking to Mr. XXXX's mother. She then called 911.
142. Ms. Jane Doe did not hear any cars or boats leave her area.
143. Ms. Jane Doe believed that Mr. Williams was there for approximately two hours in total because he told her it was 1:00 am at the beginning, and she called the police at approximately 3:00 am.
144. She did not suffer any physical injuries and did not request medical attention.
145. Despite not having seen the face of her attacker, Ms. Jane Doe offered the following description:
 - a. Perhaps between 30 and 50 years of age – to her, he seemed like a Dad;
 - b. Not that tall, perhaps a head taller than she was (5'2");
 - c. Average build;
 - d. She did not feel any facial hair;
 - e. He did not have glasses;
 - f. He did not have anything covering his face;
 - g. She thought he was wearing all black – but could not be sure;
 - h. His sweater was tight, and she ripped it at one point by grabbing at it;
 - i. He was wearing hiking boots;

- j. He tried to make his voice sound deep and breathe loud;
- k. He had a ring on his finger, but she was not sure which hand; and,
- l. He smelled dirty.

146. She described the camera as being a fancy one, not a regular digital one. It had a strap, which she found unusual, and its flash was brighter than normal. She believes he took about seven photographs in total.

Ms. YYYYY, Mr. XYXYXYXY and Mr. ZZZZZZ:

147. As noted above, Ms. Jane Doe first spoke to Ms. XXXXX, Mr. XXXXXX's mother. Ms. XXXXX told police that she received a call around 3:00 a.m. from Ms. Jane Doe, who repeatedly told her that someone had been in her house. Ms. XXXXX told her that they would be right over. She then yelled downstairs to Mr. XYXYXYXY, Mr. XXXXXX's brother, and his friend, Mr. ZZZZZZ, who was sleeping over, and told them to get dressed, and that they were going over to Ms. Jane Doe's house.

148. All three arrived at XXXXX Rd. in about 10 minutes, and knocked on the window to get Ms. Jane Doe's attention. She was on the phone, but ultimately came to the front door and unlocked it. Mr. XXXXX and [REDACTED] checked the back patio and the area between Ms. Jane Doe's house and those next to hers, but saw nothing. Mr. XXXXX believed that the back patio door was unlocked.

149. The police arrived between 10-15 minutes after the XXXXXs.

Initial Police investigation:

150. Police dispatch received Ms. Jane Doe's 9-1-1 call at approximately 3:15 a.m. Officers Young and Sharpe from the Central Hastings Detachment of the O.P.P. arrived on scene shortly thereafter, and found Ms. Jane Doe along with Ms. YYYYY, Mr. XYXYXYXY, and Mr. ZZZZZ. They quickly checked the area, including the lake for boats, but found nothing. Over the course of the morning, they also stopped and spoke to the occupants of vehicles travelling along Charles Rd., but none of the witnesses they spoke to saw or heard anything.

151. By 7:35 a.m., Identification Constable (I.C.) Jane Pellerin and I.C. Nicole Burley of the O.P.P. Forensic Identification Services (F.I.S.) unit arrived on scene and examined Ms. Jane Doe's home for evidence. Their search revealed, among other things, the following:

- a. A screen had been cut on one of the side windows to the home;
- b. Ms. Jane Doe's bed was bare of sheets and blankets;
- c. A duvet on the floor had been stripped of its cover; and,

- d. The two pillow cases Mr. Williams used to tie her hands and blindfold her were located in her daughter's bedroom.
152. Officers Pellerin and Burley also swabbed various parts of both Ms. Jane Doe and her bedroom, in an effort to find DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid) samples suitable for comparison analysis. They obtained, amongst others, a sample from the back of her neck, later determined to be suitable for DNA analysis.
153. Following Ms. Jane Doe's attack, a police K-9 unit also searched the area, but was unable to come up with any significant leads.
154. Despite a thorough investigation over the next weeks and months, that included the identification and elimination of possible suspects, the police were unable to identify Ms. Jane Doe's attacker until Russell Williams was interviewed by the police on February 7th, 2010.

Interview of Russell Williams:

155. As has been noted, Russell Williams was asked by police to attend at the Ottawa Police Station for an interview. In the course of a very detailed interview, Mr. Williams acknowledged being the perpetrator of the crimes against Jane Doe.
156. Mr. Williams told Det. Sgt. Smyth that he did not know Ms. Jane Doe. He saw her at one point from his boat (on Stoco Lake) and thought she was cute. In the early morning of September 17th, 2009, he broke into her house through a side window by cutting the screen. He was wearing a sweatshirt and dark pants, and had his face covered with the same cap he wore during his later attack on Ms. Massicotte. Ms. Jane Doe was in her bed sleeping. He stood over her for a while, and then hit her on the left side of her head with his hand, causing her to wake up. They struggled and he subdued her by lying on top of her.
157. He pulled down her top, took her pants off, and took some photographs and, according to him, left. Before doing so, he took one of her shirts, a sheet and a baby blanket because he had touched them and did not want to leave evidence of his involvement behind. He also took five pieces of her underwear. He put these in his Tweed home, and ultimately disposed of the shirt, sheet and baby blanket at the Tweed dump.
158. During the attack, Ms. Jane Doe told Mr. Williams that she had a young child, but he assured her he was not going to hurt either her or the baby.

159. He downloaded the photographs he took of Ms. Jane Doe onto his computer.

Forensic evidence and evidence seized from Russell Williams residences:

160. Male-specific D.N.A. testing of the swab from the back of Ms. Jane Doe's neck was analyzed by the Centre for Forensic Sciences (C.F.S.) and produced a partial male D.N.A. profile suitable for comparison analysis. The C.F.S. then compared this profile to that obtained from Mr. Williams following his arrest. Qualified forensic biology experts concluded that Mr. Williams could not be excluded as the source of the partial male D.N.A. profile, and that the probability that a randomly selected and unrelated male would share the same D.N.A. profile was found to be:

- 1 in 1845 Caucasians
- 1 in 1511 Blacks
- 1 in 318 Asians

161. As noted above, Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that his crimes against all four victims, including Ms. Jane Doe, were recorded on two hard drives that were in his Ottawa residence. He told Det. Sgt. Smyth that he kept everything hidden in file folders so that his wife would never discover the evidence of his criminal activities. As noted above, the police's examination of these hard drives confirmed that Mr. Williams had logged this evidence in a deeply nested and complex series of subfolders. Specifically, Det. Sgt. Jim Falconer found Russell Williams kept evidence of his crimes against Jane Doe in folders on his computer. The various folders contained:

- a. A folder containing two documents. One is labelled "Jane Doe.doc" In this document, Russell Williams has written in great detail, his attack on Ms. Jane Doe. It is a two page document, dated September 20th, 2009;
- b. The second document is labelled "The JANE DOE Series.png", and is a one page document that contains all nine of the photographs Mr. Williams took of Ms. Jane Doe during his attack on her on September 17th, 2009 (these are also saved individually in another folder):
 - The first photograph at 2:47 a.m. displays Ms. Jane Doe with the pillow case blindfolding her eyes. She is sitting at an awkward angle on the side of the bed. Her arms are behind her back, presumably tied, and her camisole top is either drooping or pulled down somewhat, partially revealing her right breast;

- The second photographs at 2:48 a.m. is a photograph taken from Ms. Jane Doe's right side, showing her head and chest area. The bed is in the background. She is blindfolded, her arms appear to be tied behind her back and her top is now pulled down revealing her right breast;
- The third photograph is also taken at 2:48 a.m. and displays Ms. Jane Doe in the same position as the second photograph. It is a closer shot photo, and the photo only reveals the top of her breasts, but it is clear from the photo that both her breasts are now exposed;
- The fourth photograph is a similar photograph, taken at 2:49 a.m. and shows Ms. Jane Doe. The photograph is taken with a wider angle and her breasts are now both exposed. Her camisole top is rolled down to her waist area;
- The fifth photograph is taken from a wider angle at 2:49 a.m. It shows Ms. Jane Doe from her nose down to her upper mid-thigh area. The camisole top is around her mid-waist, and both her breasts and pubic area are exposed;
- The sixth photograph at 2:51 a.m. shows Ms. Jane Doe sitting on the bed at a different angle. As in the other photos she remains blindfolded and the only clothing is her camisole, rolled around her mid-waist. She is visible from the blindfold area, down to her knee with both breasts and her pubic area exposed. She appears very distraught in the photograph;
- The seventh photograph at 2:51 a.m., she is sitting on the bed, turned toward the end of the bed, similarly exposed. Her legs are spread, and she appears distraught. Mr. Williams has taken this photograph from a different angle to be able to focus on her;
- The eighth photograph is taken at 2:55 a.m. Ms. Jane Doe is now fully sitting on the bed with her knees apart. She is similarly clothed and remains distraught. The photograph clearly displays her breasts and pubic area including her vagina; and,
- The ninth photograph is taken at 2:55 a.m. and shows Ms. Jane Doe sitting on the floor against a wall. Her camisole is now covering her breasts and she is now wearing pyjama

pants. She remains blindfolded and appears to still have her hands bound behind her back.

- c) A folder containing six photographs: In the first four of these photographs, dated September 17th, Mr. Williams has laid out the shirt, the sheet, the receiving blanket and the baby blanket he took from Ms. Jane Doe's house on a flat surface, and photographed them individually. In the final photograph, dated September 19th, he has photographed them grouped together, with a sign that reads: "Discarded 19 Sep 09".

Counts 75 and 76: September 18 and 22, 2009 – Two counts of Break, enter and commit theft – XXXXXXXX, Tweed

162. As noted, XXXXXXXX., Tweed, was the home of Ms. Jane Doe and her boyfriend, Mr. XXXX.
163. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he returned and broke into Ms. Jane Doe's house on two occasions after he sexually assaulted her on September 17th, 2009. The first was September 18th, when he broke into the home through an open window. He stole 15 pieces of Ms. Jane Doe's lingerie (panties and bras), took some photos and left. He downloaded the photos he took onto his computer into three folders. The first contains 15 photos dated September 19th, 2009, from 12:19-12:27 a.m. and show the inside of Ms. Jane Doe's bedroom, including pictures hung on a wall, and her lingerie, either in drawers, on her bed or on the floor. He photographed the 15 pieces of stolen lingerie individually on September 19, 2009 beginning at 10:06 a.m.
164. The next night he returned to Ms. Jane Doe's house but noticed that her boyfriend had returned and thus did not attempt to enter.
165. The next break and enter happened on September 22nd, 2009. Russell Williams broke into Ms. Jane Doe and Mr. XXXX's residence at XXXXXXXXXXXXX through an open window. He stole another 15 pieces of clothing (panties, bras and dresses). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into three folders. The first contains 13 pictures dated September 22nd, 2009, from 11:03-11:29 p.m. These pictures, again, show the inside of Ms. Jane Doe's bedroom, and contain several photos of her personal documents, including her driver's license and her insurance benefits card. The photos generally focus on her lingerie in various places. In two of the photos, Mr. Williams is standing naked, looking down into Ms. Jane Doe's underwear drawer and taking a photo of his penis draped in a thong. He later

photographed the 15 pieces of stolen lingerie individually on September 24, 2009 commencing at 12:08 a.m.

166. On October 6, 2009, he photographed all of the lingerie stolen in the September 19 and September 22 break and enters to Ms. Jane Doe's residence, collectively while laid out on a bed. Two of these photographs also include two 4x6" photos of Ms. Jane Doe, one with Mr. XXXX and one of her sitting on a beach chair.

Counts 77 and 78: September 24 and 26, 2009 – Two counts of Break, enter and commit theft – 76 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed

167. 76 Cosy Cove Ln., Tweed, is the home of Ms. Laurie Massicotte. This is three houses down from Russell Williams' cottage.
168. Mr. Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into Ms. Massicotte's home on two occasions prior to his break, enter and sexual assault of her, namely September 24th and 26th, 2009. On September 24th, he broke into the home through an open window, stole a pair of panties and left. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains eight photos, dated September 24th, 2009, from 10:52-10:59 p.m. They show the inside of Ms. Massicotte's bedroom. Specifically, they show her underwear drawer, her bed and family pictures on top of a dresser. The second folder contains four photos dated September 25th, 2009, three of which are close-ups of Mr. Williams' midsection wearing the pair of stolen underwear.
169. On September 26th, Mr. Williams again broke into 76 Cosy Cove Lane through an open window. He stole four pieces of lingerie (panties and nighties) and left. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders, the first contains 6 photos, dated September 26th, 2009, from 10:36-10:46 p.m. and show the inside of Ms. Massicotte's bedroom, and focus on her bed, lingerie laid out on her bed and her lingerie drawer. The second folder contains four photos, dated September 27th, 2009 of the stolen lingerie. There is a photograph dated February 7, 2010 at 11:39 a.m. with a sign saying "February 7, 2010 discarded."

Counts 79 and 80: September 30, 2009 – Sexual assault of Laurie Massicotte, Forcible confinement of Laurie Massicotte

Evidence of Laurie Massicotte:

170. On September 29th, 2009, Laurie Massicotte fell asleep on the couch in the living room of her residence sometime after 11:00 p.m. while watching Law and Order.
171. She was awakened to someone standing beside her and hitting her on the head. She looked up to see who it was but had trouble seeing because she did not have her glasses on. She struggled to get free from her attacker, but the more she struggled, the harder she was hit. Her attacker, Russell Williams, told her to be quiet, and that there were men in her house “taking everything”.
172. Mr. Williams placed his hand, and then his elbow, over Ms. Massicotte’s face. She could not breathe, and believed she was going to die. She found Mr. Williams to be very strong. This struggle lasted for approximately twenty minutes, during which Mr. Williams repeatedly told her to stop and that she was making it worse. She responded that she could not breathe, but Mr. Williams told her that she could not be allowed to see him. She finally suggested that he put something over her eyes as a blindfold, so she could breathe. Mr. Williams thus blindfolded her with a pillow case.
173. Over the next little while, Mr. Williams got Ms. Massicotte a drink of water and an aspirin for her headache, which had developed after he repeatedly hit her. When he got the water, Mr. Williams brought Ms. Massicotte with him, and tied her hands with what she believed to be wire. He also told her that he had to go to check on his guys, though she could not hear anyone. Upon his return, Mr. Williams began asking her personal questions about her life. He then shut all the blinds in the room. He also assured her he was not going to kill her.
174. At one point, Mr. Williams produced a knife and cut the wire tying her hands, and re-tied them with a pillow case.
175. He then started grabbing her breasts. He told her to turn around. He lifted her shirt, and tried to undo her bra. While doing this, he asked her about her boyfriend. She asked him not to touch her breasts or her bra, but he kept doing so.
176. Mr. Williams mentioned something about wanting to take a photograph of her, which made her believe she was going to be raped and killed. Mr. Williams denied that he would kill her.

177. He then started touching her stomach and trying to go down her pants, and repeated his desire to take a photograph of her. She asked why, and he responded that it was so “they” had a photograph of her. He stood up and she saw a flash.
178. He sat back down and again started to try to get into her pants. When this was unsuccessful, he got his knife and cut her shirt and bra, exposing her chest. While doing so, he again mentioned that he wanted to take a photograph of her. He also told her that she had nice breasts and that she was beautiful. He stood up, and told her to relax and that she was going to be fine. She asked if she could be covered up, but he said no, and took some photographs of her.
179. He then reiterated his wish to get into her pants. She believed he still had the knife, so she helped him remove her pants and underwear. He then told her to open her legs, but she refused. He started pushing them open, but she kept shutting them. This went on for five minutes. Ultimately, he told her he would not rape her so long as he got the photographs he wanted. She relented, and after getting a promise from him that “it” would end, she allowed him to take photographs of her with her legs open. He took more photographs, from different angles, including close-ups of her vaginal area, and from different places in the room.
180. Russell Williams then left briefly but returned, and wanted to take more photographs. He told her to stand up and helped her to do so. He took more photographs while she was standing up. She knew this was happening because she could see the flash through the blindfold and could also hear the camera.
181. He asked her if anyone would find her if he left her tied up. She said no one would.
182. Mr. Williams then went down the hall. When he came back, he said he wanted one more thing, another photograph. He told her to get on her knees and put her head down. She refused, but he said she had to, and also “don’t make me get you into position”. So, she did as told and heard him take another photograph.
183. He said he was leaving for ten minutes to go see if his friends got away, and then that he would leave for good. He took a final photograph of her covered with a blanket. She begged him not to put the photographs on the internet.
184. He told her it was 4:30 a.m. when he left. She did not hear a car or any other vehicle. She waited until 4:55 a.m., when she thought it was safe,

and called 911. She believes the police showed up approximately ten minutes later. When they arrived, Ms. Massicotte was still blindfolded and sitting on the couch, as she was too scared to move.

185. During the attack, Ms. Massicotte's fear caused her to wet herself.
186. Ms. Massicotte believed her attacker was in her house for approximately two hours. She never heard any of the "guys" Mr. Williams told her were also in the house.
187. She did not suffer any physical injuries and did not require medical attention.
188. Though she did not see Mr. Williams, she offered the following description of her attacker:
 - a. She believes he was between 30-40 yrs old;
 - b. She does not think he was a tall or big person because one of the times he had her stand up, he seemed to be beside her;
 - c. He did not have gloves on and his hands were not particularly big; she believes his arms were bare;
 - d. She did not smell alcohol; and,
 - e. She thought that she had heard his voice before.

Initial Police investigation:

189. Police dispatch received Ms. Massicotte's 911 call at 5:00 a.m. Officers Halvorsen and Hart from the Central Hastings Detachment of the O.P.P. were on scene by 5:17 am. They entered through the back door and found Ms. Massicotte sitting on the couch in the living room with a blanket covering her. She was still blindfolded and had her arms loosely tied with a pillow case and plastic vinyl ties. They observed her black shirt and brown bra, both cut through the middle, still on her body. Her pyjama pants and underwear were on the floor. The underwear contained a urine stain. They observed a mug and aspirin container on the coffee table. They also observed a piece of wire on the floor between the coffee table and couch.
190. The officers also checked the exterior of Ms. Massicotte's house. They found that a window was up at the back-side corner of the house. Ms. Massicotte believed this window had been down before that night.
191. Despite a thorough investigation over the next weeks and months, that included the identification and elimination of suspects, the police were unable to identify Ms. Massicotte's attacker until February 7th, 2010.

Interview of Russell Williams:

192. Mr. Williams told Det. Sgt. Smyth that he did not know Ms. Massicotte. He knew, however, that she lived alone because, as noted above, he had broken into her house twice before September 30th, 2009.
193. On this occasion, September 30th, Mr. Williams peered into her window and, again, confirmed Ms. Massicotte was alone. He then broke into the house through a window at the back of it, by removing the screen. Ms. Massicotte was asleep in front of the television. He had his face covered with a cap, and was wearing a dark sweatshirt and pants.
194. He approached her and struck her with a flashlight. He believed this would knock her out, but when it did not, he struggled with her. He told her he was not going to hurt her. He also told her that there other men in the house, and that it was his job to control her. She was scared she was going to be hurt or killed.
195. He then took photographs of her, with her clothes both on and off. He removed her clothes by cutting her shirt and bra with a knife, and pulling off her pants.
196. He took a pair of her underwear and left. He lived only a few hundred feet away. He went to bed and then to work as normal the next day.
197. He believes he was in Ms. Massicotte's home for approximately two and a half hours.
198. He put the underwear he stole from Ms. Massicotte in his Tweed home and downloaded the photographs he took of her onto his computer and external hard drives.
199. He told Det. Sgt. Smyth that he chose Ms. Massicotte because he knew she lived alone.

Evidence seized from Russell Williams residences:

200. As noted above, Russell Williams stored evidence of his crimes against all of his victims, including Laurie Massicotte on two hard drives seized from his Ottawa residence. With respect to Ms. Massicotte, Mr. Williams kept evidence of his crimes against her in a file that contained three folders:
 - a. A folder containing 29 photographs dated September 30th, 2009, from 2:52-4:44 a.m. These photographs were taken by Mr. Williams and graphically depict his attack on Ms. Massicotte.

- i. The first photograph on September 30, 2009 shows Ms. Massicotte fully clothed sitting on the couch, and blindfolded. Her arms appear to be behind her back;
- ii. The second and third photographs show Ms. Massicotte, blindfolded in a reclining position on the couch, with clothing only on her arms. Her legs are together, but her breasts are fully exposed. These photographs are taken at 3:54 and 3:59 a.m.;
- iii. Photographs 4 through 10 show her reclined on the couch with her legs open. They are similar and are taken in front of her. The photographs are taken at different angles, and as they progress they focus more on her vaginal area, with increasing closeness. These photos are taken between 3:59 and 4:06 a.m.;
- iv. Photographs 11 through 20 show Ms. Massicotte standing, taken at different angles. Some are taken with the Mr. Williams at a standing position and progress to him being down closer to the floor and shooting at an upward angle. The photos are directed again at Ms. Massicotte's vagina. These photos are taken from 4:06 through 4:07;
- v. Photographs 21 and 22 show Ms. Massicotte seated on the couch still blindfolded and covered with a blanket. Photograph 23 shows her still sitting on the couch, although the blanket has now been pulled to the side, exposing her breasts. These photographs are all taken at 4:08 a.m.;
- vi. Photograph 24, taken at 4:17 a.m., as described in her statement, shows Ms. Massicotte kneeling. The photograph is taken from behind and shows her buttocks, anal and vaginal area;
- vii. Photographs 25 and 16, taken at 4:17 a.m. show Ms. Massicotte kneeling on the couch naked, sitting on her legs and in an upright position. Her arms appear to be tied. These photos are taken from her left side;
- viii. Photograph 27 at 4:24 show Ms. Massicotte sitting on the couch. It shows her blindfolded, and is a close-up showing the upper portion of her breasts and her face. The end of Mr. Williams exposed penis is shown to her right side;

- ix. Photograph 28 at 4:25 shows Ms. Massicotte sitting on the couch, covered with a blanket and still blindfolded. Russell Williams' penis is featured prominently in the foreground of the photograph; and
 - x. Photograph 29 is the final photograph taken at 4:44 a.m. Russell Williams is standing fully clothed in front of a mirror wearing a black toque or skull cap and a black piece of clothing around his face. He has also placed the underwear he stole from Ms. Massicotte around his neck, and has pulled it up to cover the area from his neck to his nose, so that only his eyes are exposed. A flash from the camera can be seen in the bottom corner;
- b. Another folder on Russell Williams' computer contains two photographs, dated October 8th, 2009. In these photographs, Mr. Williams has placed what appears to be the same pair of Ms. Massicotte's underwear as is referenced in the previous folder on a flat surface and photographed it. In the second photograph, he has placed a sign reading "Discarded 08 October 09" beside the pair of underwear.
- c. There were also 10 photographs dated October 6th, 2009. An additional folder contains 12 photographs dated October 10th, 2009. In these photographs, Mr. Williams has laid out the October 7th, 2009 edition of the "Tweed News" on a flat surface and photographed the pages of the newspaper that report on the break, enter and sexual assaults, and forcible confinements of Ms. Jane Doe and Ms. Massicotte.
- d. In an additional seven photographs on Russell Williams' computer, he has placed the newspaper in his fireplace, lit it on fire and photographed it while it burned.
- e. There were also four more folders containing a total of 13 photographs of screenshots of Mr. Williams' computer, showing news and police websites reporting on the break, enter and sexual assaults, and forcible confinements of Ms. Jane Doe and Ms. Massicotte. These are dated between September 30th and November 21st, 2009.

Count 81: October 24, 2009 – Break and enter, with intent to commit theft – 690 Sulphide Road, Tweed

201. At the time of his interview with police in April 2010, the occupant of 69 Sulphide Rd. had lived at this address for 20-21 years. He has 2 sons. He is unaware of anyone having been in his home without his permission, nor has he ever noticed anything missing.
202. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 690 Sulphide Rd. through an open door. No one was home, but he quickly realized that the home belonged to 3 males and thus left without taking anything. He took four photos and downloaded them into a folder on his computer. They are dated October 25th, 2009, from 2:05-2:06 a.m., and show the inside of three different bedrooms, as well as a poster of a female on a wall.

Count 82: November 5, 2009 – Break, Enter and commit theft – 496 Minnie Ave. Tweed.

203. This was the second break and enter occurrence to the residence at 496 Minnie Ave. Mr. Williams broke into this home on November 5th through an open window. He stole nine pieces of clothing (panties, a slip and a dress). He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer. Altogether, he took 21 photographs inside the residence between November 5th, 2009, from 11:26 p.m. until November 6th, 2009 at 12:07 a.m. They show the inside of the home, meaning that Mr. Williams was inside for at least 51 minutes. The photos show what appears to be the basement, the inside of the occupants' daughter's bedroom, an underwear drawer, a closet and family pictures on top of a shelf. In the same folder, there are two photographs dated February 7, 2010 at 11:43 a.m. (the morning of the date of Mr. Williams arrest) with a sign saying "discarded February 7, 2010" together with the stolen items.
204. Within the subfolder containing the photos of the November 5th 2009 occurrence, Det. Sgt. Falconer found a Microsoft Word document entitled "4484.doc". It states:

"44/84 - Unlike last year's entry, after which I'll guess they had no idea that I'd been in the house, I made no effort to conceal this entry. In fact, I left plenty of signs that I was there (screen from back room window was left removed, with window left wide open, and the screen from the lower bathroom, where I actually gained access (like last year) was left removed - again with the window wide open. As well, I closed the back door, but didn't lock it.) On the way home the next night (Friday), at 8:00-ish, I noticed that they had returned home, and that the outside light above the back room

door was on (I'd never seen this light on...). Note: The time on these shots is one hour later than actual. "Fall back" was the past weekend, and I hadn't yet re-set my camera. Pics in Untitled Folder 2 have the correct time..."

Count 83: November 7, 2009 – Break and enter, and commit theft – 400 River Street West, Tweed

205. At the time of her police interview in March 2010, the occupant of 400 River St. W., Tweed, had lived at this address for approximately 30 years. She has 2 daughters, one of whom was 15 years old at the time of this offence. The occupant was unaware of anyone having broken into her home nor had she ever noticed anything missing.
206. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into 400 River St. W. through an open door and stole 22 pieces of clothing (panties, bras, a skirt and a slip). He told Det. Sgt. Smyth that he knew whose home this was because he saw their then 15 year old daughter's skating trophy with her name on it in her room. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer into two folders. The first contains 32 photos dated November 7th, 2009, from 10:47-11:10 p.m. (this occurrence may have been one hour earlier given what Mr. Williams said in his notation of the previous occurrence regarding daylight savings time). They show various parts of the house, including what appears to be three bedrooms. One of the bedrooms belongs to the 15 year old daughter as her name is visible on various trophies. Otherwise, the photos focus on female undergarments in drawers and on floors, and on family pictures visible on dressers. The second folder contains 23 photos dated November 8th, 2009, and are photos Mr. Williams took of the stolen clothing.

Counts 84 and 85: November 17, 2009 – Break, enter and commit theft two times – 3155 Highway 37, Belleville

207. The occupants of 3155 Highway 37, Belleville, were away on November 16th and parts of November 17th, 2009. The female occupant, who is a music teacher at C.F.B. Trenton, returned alone on November 17th, at approximately 4:30 p.m., and noticed that the bedside table belonging to her and her husband had been opened and three sex toys had been taken. She believed it was a prank, perhaps by one of her friends who lived nearby. When that proved to be untrue, she became concerned and decided to sleep at her friend's house. Given the nature of what was missing and because she believed it could still be a prank, she decided not to call the police at that point. When she left, she was

certain that she locked all of the doors. She then returned on November 18th at approximately 7:15-7:30 a.m., and discovered that all of her lingerie and three sex toys were gone. She also discovered that someone had written on her computer the words "Go ahead and call the police I want to show the judge you're really big dildoes". The back door in the kitchen was unlocked. The occupant then reported the incidents to the police.

208. Russell Williams admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he broke into this address on two occasions, November 16th and 17th, 2009, although given the timing on the photographs, the first break and enter occurred in the early morning hours of November 17th. He picked this house because he had seen that a relatively young woman lived there. On the first break and enter, he admitted that he broke into the home through an open window. This was his 2nd break and enter on that night, having already broken into Ms. Comeau's home (the details of which are below). He stole 44 pieces of lingerie (panties and bras), a sex toy and a movie. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence onto his computer. The first contains 34 photos, dated November 17th, 2009, from 4:28-5:31 a.m. (again possibly one hour earlier due to daylight savings time). These photos show the inside of the home, meaning that he was there for at least 1 hour and 3 minutes. Specifically, the photos are of what appears to be an office and a bedroom, and focus on lingerie, family photos, sex toys, a pornographic movie and, in 1 photo, a cat. There are also six photos of Mr. Williams wearing a bra and panty set while standing and masturbating. Three of these photos are close-ups of his penis.
209. The 2nd break and enter to this house occurred the next night, November 17th, when Mr. Williams broke in through an open window. He stole 116 pieces of lingerie (panties, bras and slips). He admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he left a message to the owners, taunting them to report him because he wanted to tell the police about the sex toys. He downloaded the photos he took of this occurrence into three folders. The first contains nine photos dated November 18th, 2009, from 12:02-12:14 a.m. (again, possibly one hour earlier). These photos show the inside of the home and are similar to those seen in the pictures of the previous occurrence. In two photos, Mr. Williams has taken a photo of the message he left on the computer. There are many photos in other folders dated on various dates between November 19th, 2009-February 7th, 2010. These photos show the items Mr. Williams stole from this address, including showing all the items individually and collectively on a flat surface. The last of the photos show the stolen items carefully laid out for photographing with a sign "discarded February 7, 2010". These photographs are taken between 10:48 a.m. and 11:20 a.m.

The first degree murder on Marie-France Comeau

210. At the time of her death, Marie-France Comeau was thirty-seven years of age, born April 19, 1972. She is survived by her father Ernest, who spent 42 years as a member of the Canadian Forces, and by her brother Marc-Andre. Her mother passed away from cancer in 2004.
211. Like her father, Ms. Comeau became a member of the Canadian Forces when she joined the reserves in 1995. By November of 2009, Marie-France held the rank of Corporal and worked as a flight attendant in 437 Squadron at C.F.B. Trenton. She was well-liked by her colleagues and popular.
212. In November of 2009 Ms. Comeau lived alone with her 2 cats in a 2 bedroom detached home at 252 Raglan Street, in the Town of Brighton, in the County of Northumberland. Images 1 – 3 map the area of the Province and the Town of Brighton with which we are concerned.

Count 86: November 16, 2009 – Break and Enter to Marie-France Comeau's residence – 252 Raglan Street, Brighton

213. In a police interview Russell Williams acknowledged that he had once met Ms. Comeau on a military flight and learned that she lived alone in Brighton. As commanding officer he had access to her schedule and personal information, including her home address. He learned that she was away on a military-related trip in mid-November and found out where she lived.
214. As noted above, in the evening of Monday, November 16, 2009, Mr. Williams broke into Ms. Comeau's home. He parked his vehicle some 600 – 700 metres down the street by a wooded area and from there walked to her empty house. Images 4, 5 and 6 show an aerial view of the area surrounding Ms. Comeau's home including the wooded area where Mr. Williams parked, the path that he took and the home of Ms. Comeau.
215. Mr. Williams broke into her home through a basement window. Images 7 – 9 depict the window by which he entered the home. While inside, he looked around and confirmed that she was still living alone. He went into her bedroom and located her lingerie. He played with and wore some of those garments and left, taking 7 pieces with him. He downloaded the pictures he took of this occurrence into 2 folders. The first one has 52 pictures dated November 17th, from 12:37-2:31 am, indicating that he

was in the home for at least 1 hour and 24 minutes. They show various parts of her bedroom, with the usual focus on undergarments. He also focuses on sex toys in her drawers. There are shots of her military uniform with her name on it, and what looks like an insurance benefits card with her name and picture on it. There are 18 pictures where Mr. Williams is either exposing his penis, modelling the underwear, and/or putting a purple sex toy in the underwear. The second folder has 14 pictures dated November 19th-29th, showing the undergarments he stole laid out individually for photographing.

216. In the month of November, 2009, Ms. Comeau was seeing a fellow military officer by the name of Paul Belanger. After returning home from her mid-November trip Ms. Comeau noticed that someone had been through her personal items and she accused her boyfriend, Mr. Belanger, of having done so. He vehemently denied that he had done this.

Count 1: November 24, 2009 – The first degree murder of Marie-France Comeau

217. Seven days later, on Monday, November 23rd, 2009 Russell Williams returned to Ms. Comeau's home in Brighton. Upon leaving the base at Trenton he turned off his Blackberry. Between 10:30 – 11:00 p.m. that evening, he once again parked his vehicle in the same wooded area as shown in the previous photographs and approached her home on foot.
218. He brought with him a "kit". While outside her residence he could hear her speaking on the phone in her bedroom. Image # 10 shows a telephone under the bed in the bedroom of Ms. Comeau.
219. Mr. Williams entered the home by means of the same basement window as he used before. Images 11 – 14 again depict this point of entrance which measures 2' x 5'. At the time, Mr. Williams was wearing a sweatshirt, Dockers pants and 2 pieces of clothing that masked his face.
220. Image # 15 depicts the floor plan of the basement of the home. The window by which he gained entry is located at the NE corner of the basement. Mr. Williams concealed himself in the area by the furnace and waited for some 30 – 40 minutes for Ms. Comeau to go to bed. Images 16 – 20 show the basement area as seen inside from the point of entry along with the furnace area where Mr. Williams concealed himself.
221. Ms. Comeau did not go to bed but instead came downstairs in search of one of her cats. She was dressed only in a shawl. The cat was staring

at Mr. Williams concealed by the furnace and as she walked towards it she saw him. Images 21 – 27 depict the staircase downstairs, the landing at the bottom of the stairs and the basement area as one proceeds from the landing towards the furnace area. She did not know who it was as he had his face covered. She called him a bastard and was screaming at him. He subdued her by striking her multiple times in the head area with a red flashlight that he had brought with him. On autopsy, the pathologist, Dr. Michael Pollanen, located evidence of repeated blunt impacts to her head resulting in scalp laceration and bruising which will be detailed further below.

222. His efforts to subdue her started in the area of the furnace near where drops of blood and a plastic zip tie was located by OPP identification officers on the basement floor. Images 28 – 31 show blood drops on the basement floor and the zip tie in this area of the basement.
223. The struggle between Mr. Williams and Ms. Comeau moved in a westerly direction to an area by a duffle bag. This area of the basement is shown in Images 32 – 34. Ms. Comeau fell backwards as she was chased and, at that point, was restrained by him on the floor. She bled on the floor from the injuries that she had received. A large quantity of blood was observed by OPP identification officers including bloody footwear impressions and a pattern consistent with blood soaked hair. Images 35 – 38 depict the blood residue in this area of the basement. DNA analysis of a sampling of blood on the basement floor revealed the DNA of Marie-France Comeau.
224. Once subdued, Williams used rope that he had brought with him to tie her hands. On autopsy, Dr. Pollanen observed injuries to the forearms and wrists of Ms. Comeau consistent with the application of an abrasive ligature during life. Images 39 & 40 depict those abrasions on both her right and left hands and forearms.
225. Using articles of clothing from the basement, Mr. Williams then bound Ms. Comeau to a metal jackpost support in the basement. Images 41 - 46 depict that metal support along with the garments used to bind her. Protruding from that jackpost was a metal pin as shown in images 47 and 48. On autopsy, Dr. Pollanen observed an injury to the central back of Ms. Comeau consistent with being caused by this metal pin. Image 49 depicts that injury observed by the pathologist on autopsy.
226. By this time it is now the early morning of Tuesday, November 24, 2009. Mr. Williams took 2 still photographs with a camera that he had brought with him as part of his "kit". These images show Ms. Comeau bound to the metal post in the basement. The times shown in these still photos indicate it is now 12:21 in the morning of Wednesday, November 25,

2009. These 2 photos show what appears to be duct tape covering areas of Ms. Comeau's face and in particular her mouth. Mr. Williams had brought this grey duct tape with him, also part of his "kit". The shawl can be seen draped over the left side of her body. The right side of her body is exposed and she is naked. There is a rope wrapped around her thighs and pubic area.

227. Mr. Williams then took the following steps to ensure he would be safe from detection:

- a. He looked out the basement window on the east side of the residence towards a neighbouring residence; bloody footprints were detected in this area and are denoted in the basement sketch as FW8 – 10. Images 50 & 51 show this area of the basement;
- b. He went outside and secured the screen back on the window by which he had entered the house to cover up how he had come in;
- c. He made his way upstairs to the main level of the house. Images 52 and 53 show bloody impressions on the basement floor leading to the staircase and the staircase itself. Image 54 is a sketch of the upper level of Ms. Comeau's home. Footwear impressions marked as FW 1, 11 – 14 were detected in the upper foyer of the home. Most of these reacted to a test for the presence of blood. Images 55 – 60 depict this area of the home and the footwear impressions that were discovered;
- d. He located a key for the house and broke it off inside the front door lock so that no one with a key would be able to enter the home by that entrance. Images 61 - 69 show the broken key discarded by him on the island in the kitchen and the exterior front door keyhole obstructed by the broken key;
- e. He placed a sheet over the closed blinds that covered the only window in Ms. Comeau's bedroom utilizing kitchen knives to keep it in place. Images 70 - 75 depict the front foyer leading to the bedroom and the blanket covering the window inside; and,
- f. He removed the night lites from the living room and spare bedroom upstairs. Images 76 – 81 depict those night lites, lying on the floor beneath the electrical receptacles.

228. Mr. Williams then returned to the basement area using the same staircase as shown in Image 82. A trail of blood leads from the metal jackpost to the base of the staircase. Images 83 - 85 depict that blood trail. There are signs of a struggle at the base of the stairs. Images 86 -

93 depict blood on a light switch, on the lower landing, on the drywall and on the handrail leading upstairs. There is as well an obvious dent in the drywall.

229. Ms. Comeau ended up unconscious partway up the staircase. Mr. Williams then took a further 4 still photographs of her in that state between 12:51 and 12:52 a.m. that morning. His own photos depict her lying prone on the stairs, apparently unconscious. She is completely naked. Her arms are behind her back and the rope earlier described is seen. The photographs are taken at different angles, including a close up of her vagina. As well, a close-up photo was taken of her upper body showing obvious injuries to her face and breasts. However, the duct tape that appears in his earlier photographs of her no longer covers her face and mouth area
230. After photographing Ms. Comeau on the staircase, Mr. Williams carried her up that staircase as already depicted to her bedroom. Images 94 – 96 depict the route from the staircase leading to the bedroom. There, he reapplied the duct tape that he had brought with him to her face and mouth because she had been aggressive and he believed she would scream. Images # 97 – 100 depict areas of blood staining on the carpeting in the bedroom of Ms. Comeau.
231. Over the next 1½ to 2 hours, Russell Williams sexually assaulted Ms. Comeau repeatedly. As he did so, he took both video images and still photographs of his raping her. The following is a description of what appears in the video and the accompanying still images.
 - a. The video commences with the image of a naked woman (COMEAU) laying still, prone on a bed, on her right side with her head on a pillow. She is in the fetal position with her face to the camera. The video camera appears to be positioned at the end of the bed. She has a burgundy towel wrapped tightly in a top heavy bundle around her head, secured haphazardly with silver duct tape. The tape is wound around the towel, over and under her ears, completely encompassing her mouth and eyes and down across her face and mouth in a T-shape. She has a small portion of her face exposed for breathing through her nose. Her hands are bound behind her back with an industrial type heavy green rope with a short lead, from her hands, to the excess, that is then coiled neatly in a figure eight. The camera is focused on a portion of the room where a large double bed is situated kitty corner in the room. The sheet covering the window is visible. Someone can be heard moving around out of view of the camera and the screen goes blank for a moment and then focuses back on COMEAU. 15 still photos are taken by Mr. Williams of Ms. Comeau on the bed

between 1:17 and 1:39 a.m. Some of the photographs show Ms. Comeau with her legs open and include close-ups of her vagina. In some of the photographs, Mr. Williams is using his hands to spread the opening to her vagina. He then takes a further 3 photos between 1:43 and 1:46 a.m. that show Marie-France Comeau still lying on the bed, completely naked. At this time, Russell Williams is standing beside the head of the bed completely naked except for what appears like a black balaclava on his head, exposing only his eyes. He is looking back toward the camera in two of the photographs and in the third photo he is shown fondling Ms. Comeau's breasts and vaginal area.

- b. At 00' 50" in the video, Mr. Williams clambers onto the bed, knees first and roughly pushes Ms. Comeau's left knee to one side so he can climb between her legs. He kneels between her legs, with his back to the camera and pulls her by her knees down towards him. She flops to one side, seemingly unresponsive. Her head flops down to the left resting on her chin and he re-positions her head on the pillow. Her knees are bent up and there is fresh blood, about 2 inches in length, extending down her right knee. Mr. Williams kneels above her, his back straight and plants his hands on the bed on either side of her shoulders, lining his hips and penis up over her vagina. He has bent her knees up, pressing his thighs against hers and her heels are resting on the backs of his legs. Ms. Comeau can be heard groaning and states "no" as he jostles her around. Mr. Williams begins raping Comeau. He can be seen placing his hand held camera on the bed to the left side of her, within easy reach of his right hand. He stops raping her long enough to retrieve his camera and places it behind him, between his legs. He steadies himself, with his left hand on the headboard while taking photographs between his legs of his penis in her vagina. 8 still photos taken between 1:47 and 2:01 a.m. record these acts. In the video he can be seen thrusting in and out.
- c. At 07' 28" in the video, Mr. Williams climbs off the bed and walks back towards the video camera. His movements are slow and deliberate. Ms. Comeau is left laying on the bed, groaning, her legs are spread and her vagina is clearly visible. She begins to flounder awkwardly on the bed, rolling back and forth, appearing to try to sit up, with her bound hands underneath her. Her head, tightly wrapped in the towel, flops awkwardly back and forth. Ms. Comeau can be heard groaning as she tries to swing her legs towards the side of the bed. Her head flops heavily, from side to side as if she is too weak to keep it upright. She struggles to get into a half-sitting position with her head leaning defeatedly against the headboard and her feet dangling off the edge of the bed. She flops back down

into the fetal position, with her head back on the pillow and can be heard struggling to speak. Her fingers are weakly fiddling with the rope in an effort to find the ends behind her back.

- d. Shortly after, Mr. Williams can be seen walking back past the camera towards Ms. Comeau. He climbs back onto the bed and kneels behind her. He positions his hips directly behind her buttocks and begins to penetrate her from the side. When he attempts to move Ms. Comeau, she appears to be dead weight and flops into the position where he places her. He slides himself backwards off of her, into a sitting position on the bed and stares at her buttocks, with his right hand sliding across her buttocks spreading her butt cheeks. He bends his head to look closer and stares at her anal region. Her feet are hanging limply off the edge of the bed. He appears to be thinking as he strokes absently at her buttocks and his erect penis. He gets up off the bed and walks purposefully towards the camera. He can be heard breathing heavily as he adjusts the video camera. She remains motionless on her right side with her buttocks facing the camera, her bound wrists are clearly visible and her head is on the pillow at the top of the bed.
- e. At 09' 37" in the video he climbs back onto the bed, on his knees and positions Ms. Comeau until she is flat on her stomach on the bed. He is kneeling between her legs, yanking on her hips to pull her towards him. She can be heard groaning and attempting to speak while he whispers something to her. She is trying to talk and he is directing her to "get up on your knees" while he yanks on her hips. He manages to manoeuvre her buttocks partially into the air, and begins penetrating her, while she groans. He then re-positions her while she makes a strained effort to talk through the duct tape and he whispers back "no". He then sits back and retrieves his camera. He takes more photos, holding the camera in his right hand and facing down towards his genitals and her anus. A further 11 photographs are taken between 2:06 and 2:19 a.m. that show Mr. Williams raping Ms. Comeau from behind as she is lying on her stomach. As he is doing so, Comeau struggles and wiggles her head to turn backwards towards him. She states what sounds like "get out, get out, I want you to leave, I want you to leave". He doesn't reply and continues to rape her.
- f. After forcing Ms. Comeau onto her back, at 17' 03" of the video Mr. Williams takes off his balaclava and glances at the video camera. He rubs Ms. Comeau's breasts and stomach, kisses her right cheek and looks at the camera with a half smile. He then continues to rape her, in a variety of positions. Initially, he does so while on top

of her. Later, he flips her over so that her head is facedown on the edge of the bed as he yanks her hips into position and she can be heard groaning. After penetrating her in that position, and photographing it, he orders her to “get up, get up” and yanks her into a kneeling position. He positions her directly on top of him as he orders her to “stay there”. At the end of this sequence Ms. Comeau can be heard talking. The word “please” can be heard. The duct tape covering her mouth can be seen moving as she tries to speak. She groans “oh my hands”. As he penetrates her she pleads with him to “undo her hands, that its tight and she promises that she won’t go anywhere”. Mr. Williams ignores her as he continues to penetrate and photograph her. At 31’38”, Mr. Williams climbs off the bed and walks naked to the video camera, readjusting it. Ms. Comeau can be seen struggling on the bed, attempting to sit up. She succeeds in doing so but shortly after Mr. Williams climbs back onto the bed, kisses her vagina and proceeds to rape her again, pressing the duct tape around her eyes as he does so. After awhile he stops, orders her to “stay there” and gets up off the bed. He then obtains a white tube with blue lettering of “KY” jelly and holds it in front of the video camera lens. He holds the tube between his knuckles in an attempt to avoid leaving fingerprints. He then squirts the jelly onto Ms. Comeau’s vagina and resumes penetrating her. At the end, he stops, looks at the camera and then down at his penis and appears to catch his ejaculate in his hand. He wiggles backwards off the bed, carefully keeping his hands in a cupped position and walks out of camera view. A short while later he reappears with a tissue in his hand and the toilet can be heard flushing. At 39’33” the screen goes blank. In this time period a further 12 still photographs have been taken by Mr. Williams between 2:23 a.m. and 2:39 a.m.

232. Mr. Williams told police he did not ejaculate inside Ms. Comeau nor did he use a condom. In the course of the investigation a vaginal swab was taken from Ms. Comeau along with a swab of her bloodstained right hand fingernail clippings. From each of these swabs a male DNA profile was produced. Russell Williams could not be excluded as the source of that male DNA profile. The random match probability (RMP) that an unrelated male would share the same DNA profile was found to be:
- 1 in 1845 Caucasians
 - 1 in 1511 Blacks
 - 1 in 318 Asians
233. At one point, Mr. Williams left the bedroom to check the front window to see if anyone was coming. When he did so, Ms. Comeau fled to the ensuite bathroom. Mr. Williams chased her and, after a struggle, subdued her again with more blows to her head and returned her to the bed.

Images 101 – 106 depict the state of the en suite bathroom as viewed by OPP identification officers during their examination of it. As earlier indicated, on autopsy the pathologist, Dr. Pollanen, observed discrete blunt impact injuries to the head and scalp of the deceased. It was his opinion that there were at least 5 discrete blows. These are documented in the following images: 1 to the left eyebrow area shown in Image 107, 3 to the scalp shown in Image 108 and 1 in the area of her ear area shown in Image 109. It is the opinion of Dr. Pollanen that each of these injuries is consistent with having been made by an instrument that splits the skin such as the red metal flashlight that Mr. Williams told police he used.

234. Blood was detected and swabbed from various areas in the en suite bathroom. One of those swabs was taken from the side of the bathtub in the en suite as shown in images 110 - 112. Later DNA analysis produced a female DNA profile identified to be from Ms. Comeau. Another swab was taken from the en suite bathroom sink. Images 113 & 114 depict the area of the sink that was swabbed. DNA analysis of this swab produced a major male DNA profile that was compared with the known profile of Russell Williams. It was determined that the random match probability (RMP) that an unrelated individual would share the same profile was determined to be 1 in 48 billion.
235. At 40'07" the video camera is turned back on. Ms. Comeau can now be seen lying on the side of the bed. A short while later, she is seen sitting on the edge of the bed with her head hanging down and her feet on the floor. Mr. Williams reappears in the video, still completely naked but with his face now re-concealed with the balaclava. He tells Ms. Comeau to "put her head up" and begins to take pictures of her in a sitting position. She flops off the bed landing on her knees on the floor. He whispers angrily to her to "stand up". She is heard whimpering. He pulls her back to a sitting position on the bed. She is gasping and breathing convulsively. Ultimately, she flops onto her right side, breathing hysterically and moaning. Mr. Williams takes more still photos of her in that position. Not long after, he then removes items of lingerie from a drawer and places them on top of her. More photographs are taken. In total, 7 still photos are taken of Ms. Comeau, seated on the bed, lying on the bed and with various pieces of lingerie laid across her, between 2:38 a.m. and 2:49 a.m. After shown removing these items from her at 54'46" in the video, Mr. Williams then rapes her again and films it as he holds the video camera in his hand. Ms. Comeau begins to moan and her hands can be seen wriggling in the ropes that bind her. Mr. Williams returns the video camera back onto its mount and approaches Ms. Comeau who by now is floundering from side to side, and moaning "oh, oh, oh" loudly. Mr. Williams lays forcefully on her and appears to be whispering in her ear. Comeau is mumbling, attempting to talk, stating

“no, no, please”. She can be heard saying in a muffled voice, “I don’t want to die, I don’t want to die”. Her body is shaking, and she is sobbing and whimpering. She tells him to leave her alone. Mr. Williams appears to try and suffocate her by using his hand to cover her nose and reaches for a pillow which he forces over her face. Ms. Comeau screams and kicks her legs, screaming “no” and manages to twist herself out from underneath him. She is crying out “No ... I don’t want to die”. As she twists away from Mr. Williams, he jumps off the bed and in doing so knocks the blanket covering the window off. Ms. Comeau succeeds in getting the pillow off of her face momentarily. Mr. Williams tells her forcefully to “shut up” and that if she stops moving and is quiet he’ll let her breathe. She answers “okay”. Images 115 & 116 depict a bloodstained pillow on the floor of the bedroom. As indicated, even though she was bound with rope and gagged with duct tape across her mouth, she was able to fight him off. On autopsy, Dr. Pollanen observed petechial hemorrhages in the eyes of the deceased along with injuries to her neck both of which he felt were caused by pressure being applied to the jugular veins in the neck of the deceased.

236. After fighting him off, Mr. Williams is then seen in the video reaching towards a bag on the floor and removing from it a roll of silver duct tape. As he does so, he maintains a hold of the pillow over her face. As he appears to open the roll of tape, Ms. Comeau renews her struggle with him and ends up on the floor. As she is screaming the word “no” repeatedly, Mr. Williams tells her to “be quiet and he’ll let her breathe, be quiet or he’ll suffocate her”. He pulls her into a sitting position beside the bed and orders her to be quiet. He directs her to stand and “she promises that she won’t do nothing”. He orders her to walk and pulls on the rope that binds her, directing her. He replaces the blanket over the window that has been knocked down. He pulls the balaclava back over his face. In doing so, Comeau says to him “you’re going to kill me, aren’t you”. Mr. Williams continues to get dressed and once again replaces the blanket over the window that has fallen down a second time. He then approaches her again and tells her to “get up”. She backs away from him, repeatedly saying that “she doesn’t want to die”. She tells him that she knows he is going to kill her and asks him to “go away”. He tells her that he is not going to kill her. She says “I don’t deserve to die” begs him to go away and says that she’s been good all her life. She promises that if he goes away, she won’t tell anybody that he ever came here. By this time Ms. Comeau is huddled in the corner next to her dresser. She tells him that she wants to live so badly and begs him to give her a chance. Mr. Williams walks slowly up to her and places, what is believed to be duct tape, on her nose. Ms. Comeau begins to flop around and go limp, she slumps to her knees on the floor and says “have a heart please. I’ve been really good ... I want to live”. Her head rolls slightly and rests against the wall. She stops speaking and appears to have just

suffocated to death. The video stops. It is now around 3:30 in the morning. Images 117 – 120 show the area of the bedroom in which Russell Williams watched Ms. Comeau suffocate to death after he covered her nostrils with duct tape.

237. That was the cause of death determined by Dr. Pollanen at the conclusion of the post-mortem examination. On autopsy, the sticky residue of tape was found in the area of her mouth and nasal area, residue that forensic chemists at the CFS would subsequently determine is commonly used in duct tape.
238. Russell Williams took 2 more still photographs of Ms. Comeau around the time of her death. One photo taken at 3:36 a.m. shows Ms. Comeau sitting on the floor of her bedroom near her dresser, with her back against the wall. Her arms are still restrained, and she is naked. Her face is still covered as before and her head is drooped forward.. The other, taken at 4:23 a.m. shows her lying on her stomach in front of her dresser, her arms secured behind her back. This photograph was taken after her death.
239. After he had killed Ms. Comeau, Russell Williams removed the sheets from her bed and washed them with bleach to remove from them any trace evidence of his involvement. Images 121 – 123 depict the closet showing cleaning supplies including an empty bottle of bleach. Images 124 - 126 depict the sheets from Ms. Comeau's bed as found by identification officers in the washing machine in her home. He as well videotaped and took still pictures of some of this activity.
240. Having removed the sheets from her bed, Mr. Williams then removed the duct tape from Ms. Comeau's face, mouth and nostrils. He then placed her body on the bed and covered it with a duvet.
241. Mr. Williams then retrieved Ms. Comeau's underwear and bras from her dresser (9 pieces of her lingerie in total). He left her residence by the back patio door, leaving it insecure. Images 127 - 131 depict the back patio door by which Mr. Williams left Ms. Comeau's residence. Mr. Williams did not return to C.F.B. Trenton; rather he drove directly to Ottawa because he had a "C17 Acquisition" meeting to attend. Some time after leaving Ms. Comeau's home, he discarded the shoes he had been wearing while inside and burnt the rope that he had used to bind her.
242. Marie-France Comeau's boyfriend, Paul Belanger, planned to have dinner with her that Tuesday evening, November 24th. Mr. Belanger had last spoken with Ms. Comeau on the Monday evening, November 23rd at approximately 11:30 p.m., the very time Russell Williams heard Ms.

Comeau talking to someone on the phone. Mr. Belanger tried to reach her by phone on the Tuesday but was unable to do so. She did not return his calls.

243. The following day, November 25th, Mr. Belanger decided to attend Ms. Comeau's home at 252 Raglan St., as he was getting worried about her, and it was unusual for her to not return phone calls. At approximately 12:30 p.m., he attended at 252 Raglan St. and noticed Ms. Comeau's car was in the driveway. This caused him further concern, and he believed something was wrong. He knocked on the door with no answer. He tried to open the front door, but was unable to do so. He went around to the back of the house, and found the back patio door unlocked. He shouted into the home for Ms. Comeau, but again, received no answer.
244. Mr. Belanger then entered the home, looked around briefly, and went into Ms. Comeau's bedroom. There, he found her naked body wrapped in a duvet on her bed. He called 911. Image 132 depicts the body of Ms. Comeau on her bed in her bedroom.

Initial Police Investigation:

245. The Northumberland Detachment of the O.P.P. received Mr. Belanger's 911 call at 12:59 p.m., and arrived on scene at 252 Raglan St. at 1:03 p.m. Officers Chris Dingman and Dustin Shaw found Mr. Belanger waiting for them outside Ms. Comeau's house, visibly distraught and crying.
246. Police quickly sealed off Ms. Comeau's house and otherwise secured the scene.
247. Despite a thorough investigation over the next weeks and months, which included the identification and elimination of suspects, the police were unable to identify Ms. Comeau's murderer until February 7th, 2010 when Russell Williams was apprehended.

Interview of Russell Williams and Ancillary Investigation:

248. As noted above, on Sunday, February 7th, 2010 Russell Williams was interviewed by Detective Sgt. Smyth of the OPP. In the course of this, and later, interviews, Williams admitted that he was responsible for the killing of Marie-France Comeau. He told Det. Sgt. Smyth that he killed Ms. Comeau because he thought that if she informed police about her sexual assault, including the fact that he had taken photographs, he was

concerned that investigators might make a connection between him and the three victims, given his proximity to Ms. Jane Doe and Ms. Massicotte, and his military connection to Ms. Comeau.

249. As is evident, Russell Williams took numerous photographs, and videotaped much of his attack on Marie-France Comeau, including the video that recorded her death. He then downloaded the videos and photographs onto his computer and external hard drives at his Ottawa home. He would later record his sexual assaults of Jessica Lloyd on the same Hi-8 tapes, recording over the footage of his attack on Ms. Comeau.
250. During the police search of Mr. Williams residence at 473 Edison Ave., Ottawa, two 500 Gigabyte Lacie hard drives were found hidden in the ceiling above the electrical panel of the basement. The hard drives were identical in the contents of Mr. Williams' criminal activity. In relation to Ms. Comeau, Mr. Williams kept evidence of his crimes against her in a file that contained four subfolders, which were themselves often broken down into further subfolders. The folders can be described as follows:
- a. A folder containing a copy of the video footage of his attack on Ms. Comeau. The footage was contained in one file, labelled MFC.mov. It had been created on Mr. Williams' computer on November 30th, 2009;
 - b. A folder containing the 67 photographs, dated November 24th, 2009, from 12:21-4:23 a.m. These are the still photographs taken by Mr. Williams that graphically detail his attack on Ms. Comeau;
 - c. A folder containing 11 photographs, dated November 29th, 2009. In these photographs, Mr. Williams has laid out the undergarments he stole from Ms. Comeau's residence on a flat surface, and taken individual photographs of the items;
 - d. A folder containing seven photographs of screenshots of Mr. Williams' computer showing news websites reporting on Ms. Comeau's death. The photographs are dated January 9th, 2010;
 - e. A folder containing six photographs of screenshots of Mr. Williams' computer, again, showing websites reporting on Ms. Comeau's death. The photographs are also dated January 9th, 2010;
 - f. A folder containing 33 photographs of screenshots of Mr. Williams' computer showing various websites reporting on Ms. Comeau's death, including many of the Facebook pages dedicated to Ms.

Comeau, set up by her friends and family. These are dated January 31st, 2010;

- g. Finally, a folder containing 43 photographs of screenshots of Russell Williams' computer monitor showing news and police websites reporting on Marie-France Comeau's death. They are dated November 26th-December 5th, 2009. This folder also contains a letter dated December 1, 2009 to Ms. Comeau's father prepared by Lt. Col. Komocki (Ms. Comeau's commanding officer) and signed by Mr. Williams in his capacity as Base Commander of C.F.B. Trenton, offering condolences to the Comeau family. Image 133 is a copy of that letter.

Count 2 – January 29, 2010, The first degree murder of Jessica Elizabeth Lloyd:

251. At the time of her murder on January 29th, 2010, Jessica Lloyd was twenty-seven years of age, born on May 18, 1982. She was a hard-working and reliable employee of Tri-Board Student Transportation Services in Napanee, where she had worked for approximately two years. She was very close with her mother, Roxanne, her older brother, Andy, as well as her extended family. She was very popular and had a close circle of very good friends.
252. Jessica lived alone at 1548 Hwy. 37, Belleville, which is the main road between Belleville and Tweed. This house was built for her parents, and the Lloyd family had lived at this house since 1990 when her father retired from having served 25 years with the Canadian Navy. At this time, Jessica was only eight years old and her family moved from Ottawa back to Belleville. Mr. Lloyd passed away 6 years later. Jessica Lloyd bought the family home from her mother in May 2009.
253. Russell Williams and Jessica Lloyd did not know each other. He advised that he first noticed her on January 27th, the Wednesday before her death, while she was working out on the treadmill inside her home. Jessica was getting in shape before a planned vacation to Cuba. Mr. Williams stated that he noticed her as he drove by her house on Highway 37 on his way home to Tweed.
254. On the evening of January 28th, 2010, Jessica Lloyd visited a friend, Dorian O'Brian, between 7:00 and 10:00 p.m. While she was out, Russell Williams broke into her house through a kitchen window, looked around and then left. He told police he wanted to confirm that she lived alone in the home. Ms. Lloyd returned home, and at 10:36 p.m., she text

messed Mr. O'Brian to tell him that she had arrived home safely and was going to bed. This was the last time anyone heard from Jessica Lloyd.

255. Russell Williams came back to Ms. Lloyd's house, having left his Blackberry in Tweed, and parked his silver 2001 Nissan Pathfinder in an area on Ms. Lloyd's property approximately 153 metres northeast of her house. Image #3 shows the location of her house and the approximate location where Mr. Williams parked his vehicle. He watched her house from the back of the property for a period of time before entering. Image #4 shows the rear of Ms. Lloyd's house, taken from an area where the police found footwear impressions at the back of her property where Mr. Williams was watching her house. The area he watched her house from is shown in the inset image. He re-entered Ms. Lloyd's house through the patio door. Ms. Lloyd was asleep when Mr. Williams entered her bedroom and was about to strike her when she woke up. He therefore directed her onto her stomach and tied her up with rope that he had brought with him. He also placed duct tape over her eyes. At this point, Mr. Williams began taking photographs of Ms. Lloyd. Photographs 579 through 581 (numbered according to his camera's numbering system), taken between 1:19 to 1:23 a.m. show different angles of Jessica Lloyd standing in a hallway in her home. She is wearing a black tank top and grey track pants. Her eyes are closed and her hands are restrained behind her back, tied with green rope. Photograph 582, taken at 1:23 a.m. is of Jessica Lloyd in the same position, but by this time her eyes have been covered with duct tape.
256. In addition to photographing Jessica Lloyd, Russell Williams video-taped his confinement and sexual assaults of her. The first of the video images commence showing Ms. Lloyd lying on her back on the bed. She is absolutely still on the bed, but is breathing noticeably heavily. At this time her arms are not only tied behind her back, but the rope is then tied to the headboard, confining Ms. Lloyd while Williams prepares for his attack on her. The room is lit with a flashlight, and two table lamps on each of the night tables. Three of these lamps come from other rooms in the house, and Mr. Williams has brought them into the room before he commences his attacks on Ms. Lloyd. Image number 5 shows Jessica's bedroom, with only one night table lamp on the table. Images 6 and 7 show the living room in Jessica's house. The table lamps on the end tables had been moved into Jessica's bedroom to provide him with additional light for the photographing and videotaping of his crimes against her. In these opening sequences, noises are heard in the background as Russell Williams takes photographs of some of Jessica Lloyd's underwear and other clothing found in dresser drawers and elsewhere in the room, as are displayed in the still photographs 584 through 598, taken between 1:30 and 1:41 a.m.

257. The video images reveal that she is fully compliant with the demands he makes of her. He tells her to open her mouth and then to close it, and she does so. Mr. Williams then took off Ms. Lloyd's clothes. He cut off her shirt with a knife because her hands were tied. As he starts to remove the top from her body, she arches her back to facilitate the clothing's removal. She does everything in her power to cooperate and not upset her attacker.
258. Russell Williams then takes some other photographs of Jessica Lloyd. Photographs 599 and 600, taken at 1:43 a.m. shows Jessica Lloyd flat on her back on her bed in the same position as noted above, except that her top has been completely removed and her breasts have been exposed. Photographs 602 through 605, taken between 1:44 to 1:45 a.m. show the removal of Jessica Lloyd's track pants. Initially she is photographed with her underwear in place, but then it is removed exposing her pubic area. Her underwear is left lying on her thigh. Photograph 601, taken at 1:44 a.m. is a further photograph of Jessica Lloyd's underwear on the floor.
259. At this point in the video, Mr. Williams tells her to spread her legs, and she complies. He takes the video camera off its tripod and videotapes her from her knees up, focusing on her vagina. He then videos her face and tells her to open her mouth and to close it. He then puts the video camera back on the tripod. He then says "You want to survive this, don't you?" in a quiet and calm voice. Jessica nods her head and says yes. Williams states in a quiet voice: "OK, good, you are doing good." Jessica nervously responds "OK, OK." He then commences taking further still photographs of Jessica, with the video running in it's tripod. Photographs 606 through 608, taken between 1:48 and 1:50 a.m. are of Jessica Lloyd lying flat on her back with her legs spread. The photographs are close ups of her vagina. In some of the photographs, Mr. Williams is using his hands to spread the opening to her vagina. When he places his hand on her vagina, she is startled and then tells him "Oh geez, I'm sorry."
260. Throughout these actions, Jessica remained perfectly still on the bed. When directed to position herself a certain way, she would ask in a terrified voice if she was in the right position. She would ask for permission to adjust to a different position that was not as awkward or uncomfortable. Throughout the entire sexual assaults, she was compliant and co-operative with all of Russell Williams' demands. He tells her such things as to "get your ass around to the right and put your head around to the left" and she asks him for further direction to make sure she complies with his wishes. His directions to her are often to be able to have a better angle to photograph her. He moves the lamp to the

end of the bed to get better light for his photographs, and focuses an additional light on her anus. He removes the video camera and begins to zoom in and out on her anal region. He is heard breathing heavily. He then directs Jessica to “turn around further”. As always, she complies and remains perfectly still as positioned.

261. The video then reveals Russell Williams performing oral sex on Jessica, and holds his still camera in his left hand to photograph himself doing so. Photographs 615 through 617, taken at 1:56 a.m. are of Russell Williams performing oral sex on Ms. Lloyd taken from behind. He then climbs onto the bed, gives her further direction and photographs his penis in line with her vagina, and then rapes her. He takes a number of still images of this with his camera held above her back. Photographs 618 through 621 taken between 1:58 and 1:59 a.m. are of Russell Williams raping Jessica Lloyd as they show his penis penetrating her vagina from behind. He climbs off of her and takes further still images of her. Photographs 622 and 623, taken between 2:00 through 2:03 a.m., show Jessica Lloyd remaining on her knees with her buttocks elevated. These are close-up photos of her vagina and anus.
262. He then removes the video camera from the tripod and takes close up video of himself raping her. Following that, he commands her to raise her legs in the air, spread apart, and rapes her again and takes photographs of this rape. At this point she is naked, lying on her back, with arms bound behind her back, while he tells her to “keep your feet up” as he takes photos of her. As always, she obeys his directions. Photographs 624 through 630, taken between 2:04 through 2:08 a.m. show that, Jessica has been returned to lying on her back. Her legs are widely spread and raised at almost a 90 degree angle, but bent at the knees. These photographs include close-ups of her vagina and anus and two depict Russell Williams performing oral sex on her. Photographs 631 through 636, taken between 2:09 and 2:11 a.m. are of Jessica remaining in the same position described above, lying on her back with her legs elevated and depict a further rape of her and are mostly close-ups of Mr. Williams penis penetrating her vagina. Photograph 637 taken at 2:12 a.m. shows Jessica Lloyd rolled over again and she is resting on her knees with her buttocks elevated and bent over at the waist. The rope tying her hands together is clearly seen, and it can be seen that Jessica’s hands have turned a noticeable purple colour.
263. Mr. Williams then directs her to sit on her knees straight up on the bed. Photographs 638 through 641, taken between 2:12 and 2:14 a.m. are of Jessica Lloyd resting on her knees in the same position with her buttocks elevated. One photograph focuses on her vagina. Photographs 642 and 643, taken between 2:14 and 2:15 a.m. show

Jessica Lloyd on the bed on her knees with her body in an upright position.

264. He then directs her to sit down. She sits with her buttocks on her ankles, and he takes further photographs. He then goes and gets a black zip tie and approaches Jessica. He places the zip tie around her neck from front to back. He then takes another zip tie and places it around her neck from back to front. Photographs 644 and 645 taken at 2:20 a.m. show Jessica kneeling, sitting on her lower legs. At this time there is a black object around her neck. Mr. Williams gets off the bed and asks her "what do you think is happening now". In a terrified, quivering voice, she responds "I don't know". Her mouth is quivering. She is trying to remain still. He gets the video camera from the tripod and goes over to her. She is sitting on her knees, and struggling not to cry. Her face is twitching and her mouth is contorted as she shakes on the bed. He takes more photos of her. He then says "OK, now is the test." She says OK with a cracking voice. He fiddles with the zip tie and says "you feel that?" as he pulls on the tie. She nods. He says "I feel something I don't like, I pull on that and you die, got it?" She nods and is holding back tears. He asks her "Do you want to die?" while holding the tie with his right hand. She replies "no and shakes her head. He tells her "OK, open your mouth" and remains holding the tie. He orders her to sit up and remains holding the tie, but backs away slightly. The camera is still focussed on her face. He then puts his penis in her mouth and thrusts in and out and breathing heavily. He does this several times, including taking close-up photos of his penis in her mouth as well as close-up video of the same actions, with the cameras within inches of her face. When he stops, she remains on the bed with her mouth open. He repeated these actions several times. He ejaculated after the 2nd or 3rd time he forced her to give him oral sex, and forced her to swallow the ejaculate. Whenever he placed his penis in her mouth, he would grab on to the end of the zip tie, positioning himself to carry out his threat if she did not comply.
265. Photographs 646 through 656, taken between 2:21 and 2:27 a.m. depict Mr. Williams with Jessica Lloyd, with most showing him forcing her to perform fellatio on him with different degrees of penetration. The photos are close-ups of Russell Williams' penis in Lloyd's mouth. In some of the photographs, Mr. Williams hand can be seen grasping the zip tie restraint.
266. With her chest heaving in fear, Mr. Williams tells Jessica to lay down on her back. She rolls onto her belly by mistake and then apologizes and she rolls onto her back. Photographs 657 through 659, taken at 2:28 a.m. are of Ms. Lloyd on her back on the bed with her legs widely spread. Two of the photographs focus on her vagina.

267. Mr. Williams then methodically and deliberately has her trying on underwear. While standing up, arms still bound behind her back, and her eyes taped over with duct tape, he instructs her to raise one leg, then the other and pulls a pair of panties on her. He takes time smoothing out any creases and looking at them on her, kisses her breasts, he then puts on a pink teddy and begins photographing her, taking close-ups of her face with the duct tape covering her eyes. He directs her, telling her to lie down on the bed. With her eyes covered and her arms tied behind her back, she stumbles as she is trying to find the bed in the process. Again not wanting to upset her attacker, she apologizes for stumbling. He takes more photographs of her, including focusing on the rope that ties her arms, and close-ups in between her legs. He then removes the panties and performs oral sex on Jessica and takes close-ups of him doing so with his camera. He then rapes her again, pausing occasionally to take other still photographs. Photographs 677 through 679, taken between 2:44 and 2:45 a.m. show Jessica Lloyd on her back and are close-ups of Russell Williams performing oral sex on her. Subsequent photographs would confirm that Ms. Lloyd is still wearing the pink lingerie at this time. Photographs 680 through 691, taken between 2:47 and 2:54 a.m. are of Russell Williams again raping Jessica Lloyd, with most photos showing a close-up of his penis penetrating her vagina. She is still wearing the pink lingerie, but it has been adjusted to allow for the rape to occur. The black zip tie restraint is still visible around her neck, and her hands remain tied behind her back with a rope. The last of these photographs show Jessica Lloyd after the rape, lying on the bed. After this rape, she is still positioned with her legs in the air, and she asks Russell Williams for permission to lower them.
268. Photographs 692 through 697, taken between 3:06 to 3:08 a.m. initially show that Russell Williams is taking photographs in the mirror of Jessica Lloyd's bedroom, As a result of the flash it is not clear what is reflected in the mirror. It is clear from the subsequent photographs, however, that he is again raping her. In the rape photos, she is still clothed in the pink lingerie, but it is rolled to the area around her waist. Photographs 698 and 699, taken at 3:10 are close-ups of Russell Williams again performing oral sex on Jessica Lloyd. Photographs 700 through 706, taken between 3:11 and 3:21 a.m. are of Jessica Lloyd lying on her bed. She is shown from several different angles. In some of the photographs, her legs are spread open, with a focus on her vagina. Some of the close-up photographs of her vagina show a white substance flowing downward from her vagina.
269. In addition to raping her and forcing her to perform oral sex, Russell Williams had Jessica Lloyd try on multiples items of her lingerie.

Photographs 660 through 676, taken between 2:34 and 2:41 a.m. depict Ms. Lloyd wearing pink lingerie, with photos taken from a variety of angles, and with Ms. Lloyd positioned in several different positions.

270. That night, three witnesses driving along Highway 37 passed Ms. Lloyd's house and saw an SUV or pick-up truck that was parked along the fence line to the rear of the house. These observations were made between the hours of 9:30 p.m. on January 28th to 3:20 a.m. on January 29th. In their statements to police, one witness described it as weird to see a vehicle in that location. The descriptions varied from:
- a. A silver/grey SUV, possibly a Tahoe or an Escalade, with a chrome roof rack;
 - b. Light-coloured/white pick-up truck; to a,
 - c. Dark-coloured SUV, possibly an Explorer.
271. After approximately three hours in her house, Mr. Williams forced Ms. Lloyd back to his truck and drove them back to his house in Tweed. Before leaving the residence, Mr. Williams replaces the lamps that he brought into the bedroom back into their original locations. The last of the video sequences in Jessica's house reveal sound like he is zipping up a bag and clicking tools. He is seen on the video camera dressed with a black balaclava pulled onto his head, but with his face visible, and wearing a black sweatshirt. Mr. Williams dims the video so that Jessica fades out of view. Ms. Lloyd was cooperative in leaving the house in light of Mr. Williams' repeated assurances that he would ultimately let her go if she did what he demanded. Image #8 is a photograph of Ms. Lloyd's property showing where Mr. Williams' tire tracks were later found by police. Image # is a diagram that shows Ms. Lloyd's property and details where two sets of footprints were found leading to and from the tire tracks mentioned above in image # . When they got in Mr. Williams' SUV, Ms. Lloyd sat, blindfolded by duct tape, in the passenger seat.
272. Mr. Williams arrived at 62 Cosy Cove Lane in Tweed with Ms. Lloyd between approximately 4:30-5:00 a.m. She had a shower at his residence, and he climbed in the shower with her. Photographs 707 through 709, taken between 5:56 and 5:57 a.m. show different angles of Jessica Lloyd, naked, in the shower. Jessica's eyes are still covered with duct tape, her hands are still bound with the green rope and the black zip tie remains around her neck. He also took video of Jessica in the shower and he climbs in with her. She tells him the water is a little bit hot on her arms – which are still tied tightly together behind her back. He adjusts the temperature and touches her. He takes the soap and washes her vagina and buttocks. After the shower she asks for some clothes, saying that she is freezing. He dries her off, and leaves her standing in the tub for a time, shivering.

273. Mr. Williams also told the police that he let Jessica sleep for a few hours. At some point, Ms. Lloyd had a seizure, and she told Mr. Williams that it was due to stress. She was having convulsions. The video he took shows Jessica Lloyd laying facedown in a bed and it appears to be daylight. Her arms are still tied with the green rope. Jessica states "I don't feel good" he asks "what can I do?" she says "I have to go somewhere" she asks "how far did you say you live from the hospital" he says "15 minutes". She asks "how are you going to take me there?" and he goes over to her side of the bed takes the sheets down that were covering her bum and rubs her buttocks and shoulders. He whispers to her "hey, come on, take some deep breaths, take some deep breaths." She says "get someone who can help me, if you can't take me to the hospital, take me home." Mr. Williams is leaning close to her and tells her quietly "don't make it worse for yourself, talk to me Jessica, talk to me". She appears to be intoxicated or ill. She is slurring and says "you have to take me to the hospital, you have to take me or I'm going to die". Mr. Williams lifts her up onto her sides and her breasts are exposed. She rolls onto her back and appears to be convulsing. Her eyes are still duct taped. He leans over her and rubs her face, telling her quietly and calmly "come on come on, don't bite your tongue. Relax relax try and relax, focus, stay with me, Jessica" she convulses upwards towards him and he again tells her in a whispering voice "relax Jessica don't bite your tongue, don't bite your tongue" She convulses again and struggles to speak "you have got to take me somewhere; I'm going to die if you don't". He says "ok ok" in a whisper. She continues to gag and stutters "you have to tttttake mee sossssoomewhere" while he cradles her face. He holds her face towards him and whispers "what can I do to help you, what can I do to help you in the meantime?" She says "don't let me bite my tongue, don't let me bite my tongue" She states "we have to go because I only have twenty minutes from the time it starts" he whispers "hold on" as she falls back onto the bed. She is at the end of the bed crouched in the fetal position and extremely distressed and shaking. He calmly goes back to the camera and he turns the camera so that she is clearly back in view while she suppresses gags and convulses. Even while she is in extreme distress, he deliberately turns the camera to capture her. She leans over and says "I know I can't put anything in my mouth because I will swallow my tongue" and he puts his hand on her back to steady her. He tells her "stand up, can you stand up" She leans forward and retches while he retrieves a white wastebasket from the side of the bed for her to vomit into. She is crying "we have to go we have to go, I don't want to die". She is crying and saying "I should've told you this last night I never even thought, I'm sorry" He holds her up and is whispering "shh shh" She is extremely upset and crying and continues to beg him to take her to a hospital or somewhere she can get some help. He tells her "come on stand up" and looks towards the camera while brushing her hair out of her eyes. He appears to continually be

conscious of the position of the camera even as she is in obvious distress. She begs him “can you drop me off?” and falls to the floor growling and retching. She says “please I’m begging you, can you?” and he looks at the camera and puts his hand towards her mouth. He is crouched behind her holding her chin, leaning over her and she states “you don’t understand, I’m not making it up” while crying. He is whispering “Jessica, Jessica” and she is stating “if you don’t take me I’m going to die” He says “stand up we will put something on you” she says “ok ok” and attempts to stand. He tells her to stand up and she stumbles around feeling her surroundings. She says “I won’t look, I won’t look”. He says to her quietly “we need to get you dressed, you are doing very well, I will get your jeans” She begs him “you need to get this rope off me, I won’t do anything, I promise”. Williams continues to try and hold Jessica up while she stumbles and is hunched over at the waist. She sticks out her tongue and says in garbled speech “I think I bit my tongue”. Williams picks up her jeans from the floor and attempts to put her feet in them. She waves her hand around and slurs “I’m not going to do anything” She is crying and saying “I’m so sorry, I should have told you. Do you promise to take me to the hospital?” in a desperate voice. He takes the rope off of her legs and pulls her jeans on. She still convulses and is bent over while he goes behind her and loops her belt. “Hang in there baby, hang in there” He whispers. She tells him her sweater is on the floor and he puts her arms in the sleeves. “Can you take this rope off?” she cries. “I promise I won’t try to do anything” and he starts to take off the rope. He is saying “hang on hang on” while she cries desperately with her voice cracking “I don’t want to die please” Jessica is partially dressed now and he is still naked. She is crying as he pulls her sweater over her head and says “if I die will you make sure my mom knows that I love her”. She can be heard crying as he leads her out of the room. This segment ends as Williams can be heard shutting off the camera.

274. Mr. Williams advised that he then let her sleep for another hour. Photographs 710 through 713, taken between 11:40 a.m. to 1:18 p.m. show Jessica Lloyd fully clothed. Initially she is sitting in a crouched position and then she is lying down on the floor, apparently sleeping. The rope has been removed but the duct tape remains covering her eyes. It cannot be seen whether the zip tie is still around her neck. Mr. Williams also takes video of her sleeping on the floor.
275. Meanwhile, at approximately 9:00 a.m., Jessica Lloyd’s mother, Roxanne, received calls from Jessica’s supervisor at Tri-Board Student Transportation to say that Ms. Lloyd had not come into work that morning and had not called. He noted that this was unusual for her to not show up at work at all, and even more so to not call to report her absence.

276. At approximately 9:30 a.m., Roxanne Lloyd went to Jessica's house, stopping at her doctor's office along the way to see if she was there. She ultimately arrived at Jessica's house and noticed that her car was in the driveway. The front and back doors were locked, but Ms. Lloyd was able to get inside with her own key. Once inside the house, she noticed that Jessica's purse, keys and Blackberry were there as well. She searched the entire house as well as the back deck, and saw no sign of Jessica. She began calling friends and family members.
277. Over the course of the morning, family members and friends arrived at Jessica Lloyd's home. Some of Ms. Lloyd's family members helped clean the house. They did not change any of the bedding. After some discussion and more searching, they decided to call police.
278. Belleville Police Service (B.P.S.) officers arrived at Ms. Lloyd's residence at 12:18 p.m. Constable Dan Hounslow along with Det. Cst. Jeff Holt, a F.I.S. officer, both with the B.P.S., located a set of footwear impressions leading toward the rear of Jessica Lloyd's house as well as a similar set from the rear of her home towards a fence line at the back of her property. The set heading away from the residence appeared to be accompanied by a second set of footwear impressions, smaller in size than the first. They followed these footwear impressions and were ultimately led to a set of tire tracks approximately 150 metres from the house. The police photographed and measured the tire track impressions. The footwear impressions were also photographed.
279. Back at 62 Cosy Cove Lane, Ms. Lloyd woke up. Russell Williams videotaped her as she went to the washroom and then washed her hands. Mr. Williams told her that, before allowing her to leave, he wanted to take more photographs of her and have sex with her again. To this end, he had her put on a number of different items of lingerie that he had taken with him from her house, and photographed and videotaped her wearing the lingerie. As he undresses her, she snuffles, and he asks her "You alright?" He then removes her clothing. As he photographs and videotapes her, he again gives her orders as to how to position herself and she complies throughout.
- a. Photographs 714 through 720, taken between 1:34 and 1:36 p.m. are of Jessica Lloyd standing naked. The duct tape remains covering her eyes and the zip tie remains around her neck. The rope has been removed from her arms, and there is noticeable bruising on her arms from where the rope was tied.
 - b. Photographs 721 through 874, taken between 1:38 and 3:03 p.m., show Jessica Lloyd being required to model 10 different pieces of lingerie and underwear that he has brought with them from her

residence. The photographs are taken from a variety of different angles. In many instances the photographs are focusing on her vaginal area. While wearing four of the outfits, Jessica Lloyd is shown being required to perform fellatio on Russell Williams. While wearing one of the outfits, Russell Williams has photographed himself performing oral sex on Jessica Lloyd. The video he takes shows him adjusting the zip-tie that is around her neck to position the end behind her neck for the photographs, as well as him methodically adjusting the lingerie. At one point he gets a pair of shears and cuts off the end of the zip tie, presumably so it shows less in the photographs. During this time, Jessica appears to have trouble breathing and puts her hand to her chest. She appears overwhelmed. He says something to her that cannot be heard on the video and she apologizes. He then continues taking photos. Throughout this time frame, he is extremely deliberate and calm in his actions.

- c. Photographs 875 and 876, taken between 3:07 and 3:08 p.m. show Jessica Lloyd lying on her back on the bed. She is nude. The photographs are close-ups of Russell Williams performing oral sex on Ms. Lloyd.
- d. Photographs 877 through 880, taken between 3:08 and 3:13 p.m., are of Jessica Lloyd lying on the bed on her back with her legs spread. The duct tape is still on her eyes and the twist tie is around her neck. The photographs include close-ups of her vagina.
- e. Photographs 881 through 890, taken between 3:22 and 3:27 p.m. show Jessica Lloyd on her back on the bed. Russell Williams again rapes her. Several photographs show Williams' penis penetrating her vagina. The video as well shows him raping her with her at times wincing and whimpering. At one point he withdraws his penis, wipes it and wipes it onto her face, and then wipes his penis again and wipes it onto her chest. He then continues to rape her and kiss her at the same time. He periodically looks toward the video camera. Mr. Williams then again performs oral sex on Ms. Lloyd. Two photographs are close-ups of him doing so. The final photographs are of Jessica Lloyd lying on her back on the bed with her legs spread and elevated. Several of these photographs are close-ups of her vagina.
- f. Photographs 891 to 892, taken between 4:02 and 4:04 p.m. are of Jessica Lloyd lying on her back on the bed. In the first photograph she is covered by a white sheet but in the second by both a white sheet and comforter. Only her face can be seen. Her eyes are still covered by the duct tape.

280. Following these rapes, Mr. Williams gave Jessica some fruit and led her to believe they were leaving.
- a. Photograph 893, taken at 5:45 p.m. is of Jessica Lloyd sitting up on the bed. She is now dressed in blue jeans and a 'Roots' hoodie. The duct tape is still over her eyes. A plate of food is on her lap.
 - b. Photographs 894 and 895, taken at 7:30 p.m. show Jessica Lloyd lying on the bed, still clothed. The duct tape has been removed from her eyes. Her eyes remain closed.
 - c. Photographs 896 through 899, taken between 7:39 and 7:41 p.m. are of Jessica Lloyd on the bed lying on her stomach face down. She is still clothed in the same clothes described above. The duct tape has again been placed on her eyes. Her arms are behind her back and have again been tied around the wrists with the green rope.
 - d. Photograph 900, taken at 7:50 p.m. is of Jessica Lloyd sitting up. The photograph is of her upper chest and head. She is still wearing the same hoodie. Her eyes are covered with duct tape. She is broadly smiling.
 - e. Photographs 901 through 902, taken at 8:07 p.m. are of Jessica Lloyd sitting on the edge of the bed with her feet on the floor. She is fully clothed in the same clothing described above. She is wearing a pair of shoes. Her arms are behind her back and the rope securing them is visible. There is duct tape over her eyes but now duct tape has also been placed over her mouth. Her nose remains unobstructed.
281. As she began walking, however, Mr. Williams struck Jessica Lloyd on the head with a flashlight. He believed this caused her to be unconscious on the floor. He then strangled her with some rope, and did so until her body stopped moving. Photographs 903 through 905, taken between 8:18 to 8:19 p.m. show Jessica Lloyd lying face down on the floor. There is a large flashlight beside her. In Russell Williams' statement he admitted that he struck Ms. Lloyd over the head with that flashlight. The photographs are taken at different angles with two focusing on the area of her head and show a large expanding pool of blood around her head. Mr. Williams tried to clean this blood. Mr. Williams then placed Jessica's body in his garage and, according to him, drove back to C.F.B. Trenton. By this point, it was between approximately 9:00-10:00 p.m.

282. Mr. Williams stated to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he stayed at the Base on the night of Friday, January 29th, because he had a flight early the next morning. He flew some troops to California on Saturday, January 30th, returning to CFB Trenton at approximately 6:30 p.m. He worked in his office and then drove to Ottawa, where he stayed until Tuesday, February 2nd. At that point, he returned to Tweed and on the Tuesday night, he drove Ms. Lloyd's body to the point on Cary Rd. where she was later found. He chose that spot because there were no houses around. He returned to his Tweed home, where he vacuumed his house and wiped the floors. He did the same to his truck.
283. He admitted to Det. Sgt. Smyth that the reason he killed Ms. Lloyd was because he was fearful that her story would be recognized given his sexual assaults upon Ms. Jane Doe and Ms. Massicotte.

Further Police Investigation:

284. Sgt. Grant Boulay, of B.P.S. F.I.S., analyzed the footwear impressions found on Ms. Lloyd's property leading to the tire tracks. With respect to the smaller footwear impression, he compared them to the impression of a boot Ms. Lloyd was known by her family to wear, Ms. Lloyd's own boots were never found. Sgt. Boulay found that there was an agreement of class characteristics between the two impressions, meaning that the boot Ms. Lloyd was known to wear could have created the impression found by police in the snow behind Ms. Lloyd's residence. These comparisons are seen in image #9.
285. With respect to the tire tracks, the B.P.S. contacted Jamie White, a collision investigator at Transport Canada, who measured the tire track impression taken from the rear of Ms. Lloyd's home. From them, Mr. White developed a list of vehicles capable of matching the wheelbase. As the witnesses had described a truck or SUV, cars were excluded from consideration, and according to Mr. White, vehicles capable of making those impressions included:
- a. 1996-2002 Toyota Forerunners
 - b. 1999-2004 Jeep Cherokees
 - c. 1998-1999 Nissan Pathfinders
286. Sgt. Boulay also contacted Mr. Thomas Rogerson, a footwear and tire impression analyst, and civilian member of the R.C.M.P. and provided him with the photographs and measurements of the tire impressions, in order for a profile tire to be developed. Mr. Rogerson concluded that a tire capable of making that impression was a Toyo Open Country tire. Based upon further comparisons conducted by Sgt. Boulay, the police focussed on a vehicle with Toyo Open Country HT tires. Image #10

shows the left front tire track that was found, and was used for the tire comparison.

287. By February 4th, 2010, the Belleville Police Service and O.P.P. had considered that the break, enter and sexual assaults, the murder of Marie-France Comeau and the disappearance of Jessica Lloyd were possibly connected. To that end, they established a multi-jurisdictional investigation.
288. Between February 4th and 7th, the police conducted numerous canvasses, including:
 - a. A residence canvass of all houses in an area along Highway 37 between Belleville and Tweed, and 1 kilometre in each direction of Ms. Lloyd's residence. This canvass ultimately covered 285 homes;
 - b. A vehicle canvass of all vehicles registered to people living in Belleville and the surrounding area that matched the description generated from the observations at Ms. Lloyd's residence, based on M.T.O. records. This canvass generated approximately 450 vehicles, 178 of which were located and whose owners were questioned by police; and,
 - c. A canvass of all known sexual offenders in the area based on information gathered from the Sexual Offenders Information Registry Act (S.O.I.R.A.). This canvass led the police to question four men in the area.

The Roadside Canvass:

289. The police's priority was to identify the vehicle that left the tire impressions behind Ms. Lloyd's house. To that end, they decided to set up a roadside canvass on Highway 37 outside Ms. Lloyd's house on the evening of February 4th, 2010, one week following her disappearance. Officers were instructed to stop each vehicle and question the occupants pursuant to questions from a questionnaire. If any vehicle and tires matched the profiles generated by the Ministry of Transportation and R.C.M.P., the drivers would be asked to pull to the side of the road for additional questions.
290. The canvass was set up shortly before 7:00 p.m. on February 4th. Russell Williams was stopped at approximately 6:57 p.m., within minutes of the canvass being set up. He was driving a 2001 Nissan Pathfinder with Toyo Open Country HT tires. He was asked to pull over for questioning. He admitted that he regularly travelled on that highway,

given that he was the Base Commander at C.F.B. Trenton, and resided on Cosy Cove Lane in Tweed. He also admitted being on Highway 37 on the night of January 28th, 2010, but stated that he did not see anything unusual. He claimed not to have known Jessica Lloyd. Mr. Williams then left, driving northbound. Image #11 shows the tire track image left on Ms. Lloyd's property and a test impression that was later taken by the police from the front left tire of Mr. Williams Pathfinder. Image #12 shows Mr. Williams pathfinder, and the left front tire of his vehicle.

291. Based on the information gathered at the roadside canvass, his residence's proximity to the break, enter and sexual assaults of Ms. Jane Doe and Ms. Massicotte, and the fact that Mr. Williams worked with Ms. Comeau, the police viewed Mr. Williams as a suspect. They therefore began conducting surveillance of him. On the morning of February 7th, the O.P.P. Surveillance Unit followed him to a car wash in Ottawa, where he was seen vacuuming and cleaning his Nissan Pathfinder. After he left, the police seized the contents of the vacuum canister.

Search warrants:

292. Shortly after the February 4th canvass, the police also began preparing search warrants for Mr. Williams' homes in Tweed and Ottawa, as well as for his Nissan Pathfinder and for his office at C.F.B. Trenton. On February 7th, Justice Robert Graydon of the Ontario Court of Justice granted the police search warrants for Russell Williams' residences and Nissan Pathfinder.

Interview of Russell Williams and discovery of Jessica Lloyd's body:

293. Prior to the execution of the search warrants the police invited Russell Williams to come to the Ottawa police station to be interviewed. Det. Sgt. Jim Smyth, of the O.P.P. Behavioural Sciences Unit, called Mr. Williams in Ottawa shortly before 2:00 pm on February 7th and told him he was investigating the disappearance of Jessica Lloyd. Mr. Williams agreed to come into the Ottawa Police station to give a statement at 3:00 p.m.
294. Mr. Williams arrived at the Ottawa Police station and was escorted into an interview room and Det. Sgt. Smyth began to interview him at 3:03 p.m. The interview was being monitored by several members of the O.P.P., including D.I. Dave Quigley, Det. Sgt. Ed Chafe, Det. Sgt. Steve Coburn and D.I. Paul McCrickard.
295. Det. Sgt. Smyth told Mr. Williams that the police were investigating four offences, the break-enter and sexual assaults of Laurie Massicotte and Jane Doe, the murder of Marie-France Comeau and the disappearance

of Jessica Lloyd. He advised Mr. Williams of his right to counsel and gave him the standard police caution. Mr. Williams declined an opportunity to contact counsel. Det. Sgt. Smyth then questioned Mr. Williams on his background and on his knowledge of the four offences and of his whereabouts during the four offences. Det. Sgt. Smyth later asked for and received consent from Mr. Williams to obtain:

- a. A sample of his D.N.A.;
- b. An impression of his boot tread; and,
- c. His Blackberry for analysis.

296. All three items were preceded by a full caution and consent search forms in accordance with R. v. Wills outlining to Mr. Williams his legal rights in each circumstance. Mr. Williams voluntarily provided each item. This process lasted from approximately 4:30-5:04 p.m.

297. Det. Sgt. Smyth turned the footwear impression over to other officers monitoring the interview. Collectively, they compared the footwear impression provided to them from Mr. Williams to the photograph of the footwear impression seized from the area behind Ms. Lloyd's house on January 29th. They concluded the impressions were similar. Images #13 and 14 show the impression of Mr. Williams footwear obtained near the fire pit behind Jessica Lloyd's house, and Mr. Williams boot with the tread pattern, as well as the points of comparison. At this point, the police decided that given the evidence they had accumulated to that point, Mr. Williams was likely responsible for Jessica Lloyd's disappearance.

298. Det. Sgt. Smyth continued to question Mr. Williams (who had yet to admit his involvement in any of the offences) and, at approximately 6:21 p.m., he confronted Mr. Williams with the footwear impressions and the fact that the police were on the verge of executing search warrants at his residences. At 7:41 p.m., after a skilled and persistent interview by Det. Sgt. Smyth, Mr. Williams advised Det. Sgt. Smyth that he wanted to minimize "...the impact on my wife". He then directed Det. Sgt. Smyth to get a map so that he could show him where Jessica Lloyd's body was located. A map was provided and Mr. Williams directed him to an area on Cary Rd., between East Hungerford Rd. and Marlbank Rd., approximately 10 km. east of Tweed. He told Det. Sgt. Smyth that Ms. Lloyd's body was 40 ft. from the roadway, at a distance approximately .7 km south of East Hungerford Rd. Mr. Williams confirmed that Ms. Lloyd was dead, and had been dead since Friday, January 29th. He also told police that photographic and video evidence of his offences against Ms. Lloyd could be found in his Ottawa home. Det. Sgt. Smyth asked Mr. Williams whether evidence of the offences against Ms. Comeau, Ms. Massicotte and Ms. Jane Doe would be found as well. Mr. Williams replied that it would.

299. Russell Williams was formally arrested for the murders of Marie-France Comeau and Jessica Lloyd, and the break, enter and sexual assaults of Ms. Jane Doe and Ms. Massicotte. He was given his rights to counsel and caution, and given an opportunity to contact a lawyer, which he declined. Det. Sgt. Smyth continued to interview him until approximately 1:33 am. As noted throughout this statement of facts, during the course of the interview, Russell Williams confessed to all of these offences.
300. The police, meanwhile, armed with the information from Mr. Williams on the location of Ms. Lloyd's body, started looking for her, but were having difficulty. Det. Sgt. Smyth asked Mr. Williams if he would lead them to Ms. Lloyd's body. Mr. Williams agreed, and he left the Ottawa Police station in the custody of Det. Sgt. Smyth and Det. Sgt. Coburn at 1:33 a.m. At 3:47 a.m., they arrived at Cary Rd. and Mr. Williams directed them to Ms. Lloyd's body. Det. Sgt. Smyth found Ms. Lloyd behind a rock, wrapped in towels and duct tape. She was wearing jeans and a shirt. Images 14, 15 and 16 show the area of Cary Road where Jessica Lloyd's body was found are photographs of the area where Ms. Lloyd's body was found.

Post-Mortem Examination and Forensic Analysis:

301. Dr. Pollanen performed the autopsy of Ms. Lloyd and concluded that the cause of her death was strangulation.
302. Ms. Lloyd also suffered the following further injuries:
- a. Significant blunt impact trauma to the head, including two lacerations Image #19 is a photograph taken at Ms. Lloyd's autopsy showing the laceration caused by Mr. Williams when he struck her on the head with the flashlight.
 - b. Abrasions and bruising on both of her forearms and wrists Image #20 shows Jessica Lloyd's right arm, and the ligature marks caused by her arms being tied with a rope.
 - c. Abrasions on both of her legs; and,
 - d. Abrasion to her back.
303. I.C. Jane Pellerin of the O.P.P. was present during the post-mortem examination. Among her other duties during the examination, she seized two swabs of Ms. Lloyd, one from a vaginal smear and one from her right hand fingernail clippings, for the purposes of D.N.A. analysis.

Forensic evidence and evidence seized from Russell Williams' residences:

304. As noted above, swabs were obtained from a vaginal smear taken from Jessica Lloyd and from her fingernail clippings. The results were as follows:
- a. The swab from the fingernail clippings produced a male D.N.A. profile at two different loci (6 STR loci and 12 Y-chromosome STR loci) suitable for comparison analysis. The C.F.S. compared these profiles to that obtained from Mr. Williams. They concluded that Mr. Williams could not be excluded as the source of the first of these profiles (6 STR loci), and that the probability that a randomly selected individual unrelated to Mr. Williams would share that profile is 1 in 2500;
 - b. The swab taken from Ms. Lloyd's vaginal smear contained semen. D.N.A. analysis of that semen produced a male D.N.A. profile. The C.F.S. compared this profile to that obtained from Mr. Williams. They found that Mr. Williams could not be excluded from either this profile nor the second of the two loci generated from the profile obtained from the fingernail clippings (12 Y-chromosome STR loci) above, and that the probability that a randomly selected and unrelated individual would share the same D.N.A. profile with both of those items was found to be :
 - 1 in 1845 Caucasians
 - 1 in 1511 Blacks
 - 1 in 318 Asians
305. As a result of the police searches, Hi-8 video tapes and a SanDisk memory card were found secreted in the piano at 62 Cosy Cove Ln., Tweed, on February 13th, 2010 as Russell Williams had described to Lt. Comm. Merriman. The SanDisk memory card contained 325 photograph images dated January 29th, 2010, between 1:19 a.m. to 8:19 p.m. that have been referred to. The two Hi-8 tapes contained the video footage Mr. Williams created of his attack on Jessica Lloyd. E-Crimes officers viewed the videos and created a synopses of them
306. The two 500 Gigabyte Lacie hard drives found hidden in the ceiling above the electrical panel of the basement at 473 Edison Ave., Ottawa contained identical evidence of Mr. Williams' criminal activity. Specifically, police computer examiners found:
- Evidence of Russell Williams' crimes against Jessica Lloyd were contained in a file with three subfolders, which were themselves broken down into further subfolders.
- i. A folder containing a copy of the video footage from the Hi-8 Tapes (described above) depicting Mr. Williams' attack on Ms. Lloyd. The footage was contained in two files, labelled JEL1of2.mov and JEL2of2.mov. They had been created on

the Lacie hard drive on the afternoon of February 1st, 2010, meaning Mr. Williams had transferred the videos from the Hi-8 tapes to the external hard drives on this date;

- ii. A folder containing the same 325 photograph images of Jessica Lloyd that were on the SanDisk memory card;
- iii. A folder containing 45 photograph images dated February 6th, 2010. In these photographs, Mr. Williams has laid out the lingerie that he stole from Ms. Lloyd on a flat surface and photographed the items individually. In his final photograph in this collection, he has laid out a number of 4x6" photographs taken from Ms. Lloyd's house, showing her and her friends, along with her student card;
- iv. A folder containing 53 photographs of screenshots of Mr. Williams' computer screen showing various news, chat and police websites describing Ms. Lloyd's disappearance and the efforts made to find her. In one photograph, Mr. Williams is looking at a Belleville Intelligencer website article describing how the ground search for Ms. Lloyd had been called off by police. Right beside that browser, he is watching the video of him attacking Ms. Lloyd. These photographs are dated between February 1st and 6th, 2010;
- v. A folder containing 34 photographs of screenshots of Mr. Williams' computer screen, again of various news websites, as well as Facebook pages, all discussing Ms. Lloyd's disappearance and efforts to find her. These are dated January 31st;
- vi. A final folder containing 3 photographs of screenshots of Mr. Williams' computer screen, again showing websites discussing Ms. Lloyd's disappearance. These photographs were dated January 31st, 2010.

Further Police Investigation following the arrest of Russell Williams:

307. During and following Mr. Williams' confession, the police continued their exhaustive investigation of Mr. Williams.
308. The police obtained and executed search warrants for the following addresses during the following time periods:
 - 1) 62 Cosy Cove Lane, Tweed – Mr. Williams' residence. Image #21 shows Mr. Williams residence at 62 Cosy Cove Lane in Tweed.:

- a) Search warrant #1 – from 3:08-9:35 p.m. on February 7th, 2010. This search was performed by members of the O.P.P. and Belleville Police Service and, in particular, led by F.I.S. officers Jane Pellerin and Warren Easby. It uncovered the following significant items:
- Red staining on the living room floor;
 - Leatherman knife from the dining room table;
 - Various camera and video recording equipment;
- b) Search warrant #2 – from 10:45 a.m. on February 11th-2:05 p.m. on February 18th, 2010. This search was performed by members of the O.P.P. and Belleville Police Service and, in particular, led by F.I.S. officers Dave Tovell, Gord Lefebvre and Nicole Burley. It uncovered the following significant items:
- Red staining found on a drawer in the master bedroom, on a wooden chair and its cushion in the living room, and in the bathtub, ;
 - Two Hi-8 Tapes wrapped in black electrical tape, secreted within the piano, the contents of which have been described above Images #22 through 24 show the piano in the living room and the Hi-8 tapes and memory card that were hidden within it;
 - A SanDisk 4 Gigabyte Memory Card – attached to one of the Hi-8 tapes found secreted in the piano, the contents of which have been described above;
 - Electrical and duct tape;
 - Rope;
 - A military-style duffle bag in the top cupboard of a closet containing 8 plastic bags, containing a large quantity of female undergarments/clothing and sex paraphernalia, specifically:
 - a. Bag #1:
 - i. 93 pairs of women's panties and 1 slip;
 - b. Bag #2:
 - i. 4 camisoles, 6 tops, 13 dresses and 1 t-shirt;
 - c. Bag #3:

- i. 2 women's bathing suits, 2 bathing suit bottoms, 8 pairs of panties, 1 pair of tights, 18 camisole tops, 1 pair of fishnet stockings, 1 garter and 1 garter belt;
 - d. Bag #4:
 - i. 1 nightie, 1 panty and camisole set, 1 camisole, 1 pair of panties and 1 slip;
 - e. Bag #5:
 - i. 51 pairs of panties;
 - f. Bag #6:
 - i. 35 pairs of panties;
 - g. Bag #7:
 - i. 67 pairs of panties, 3 bathing suit tops, 2 bras, 1 bathing suit bottom, and 2 socks;
 - h. Bag #8:
 - i. 49 bras;
 - i. Various sex toys; and,
 - j. 4x6" photographs of Ms. Jane Doe seemingly on vacation with her boyfriend and friends
Image 25 through 33 show some of the contents of the duffle bag;
 - Black multi-purpose zip ties, one example shown in image 34; and,
 - A quantity of computer equipment;
- 2) 473 Edison Ave., Ottawa – Mr. Williams' residence:
- a) Search warrant #1 – from 5:36 p.m. on February 7th-1:10 a.m. on February 8th. Det. Insp. Quigley, who was monitoring Det. Sgt. Smyth's interview of Mr. Williams, contacted Det. Sgt. Mason of the O.P.P., who was overseeing the execution of the search warrant of Mr. Williams' Ottawa home. He advised him to stop the search of this residence at approximately 8:30 p.m., after Mr. Williams confessed, to enable them to get a new warrant, which would contain the details of Mr. Williams' confession.
 - b) Search warrant #2 – from 12:32 p.m. on February 11th to 3:04 p.m. on February 18th (7 days). This search was conducted by members of the O.P.P., in particular led by Ident. Cst. Pellerin. This search uncovered the following significant exhibits (among many others);
 - A book entitled "LSI Guide to Lock Picking";

- Sony Digital Camera;
- A black skull cap found in a duffle bag beside the bed in the master bedroom;
- Mr. Williams' Air Force flight suits;
- More computers and computer related equipment. In particular, the two previously described 500 gigabyte Lacie external (USB) hard drives concealed in the basement ceiling above the electrical panel, where Mr. Williams told Det. Sgt. Smyth they would be in his February 7th interview. Images 35 through 38 show where the hard drives were hidden;
- An Epson Printer box in the basement spare room containing 2 plastic bags, containing:
 - a. Bag #1:
 - i. 13 pairs of women's panties
 - ii. 3 bras
 - iii. KY lubricant
 - b. Bag #2:
 - i. 8 photographs of Jessica Lloyd
 - ii. Student photograph ID of Jessica Lloyd
 - iii. 4 camisoles
 - iv. 1 pair of grey sweat pants
 - v. 10 bras
 - vi. 22 pairs of panties

This was the box which Russell Williams acknowledged to Det. Sgt. Smyth that he had placed the undergarments from all four of his sexual assault victims, and the box and it's contents are displayed in images 39 through 42;

- A "KRK Systems" box in the basement spare room containing a plastic bag with female underwear and a ziplock bag with lubricants
- An "APC Battery Backup" box in the basement spare room containing 2 bags, containing:
 - a. Bag #1:
 - i. 4 vibrators
 - ii. Commercial "Real Sex Home Videos"
 - iii. 6 batteries
 - b. Bag #2:
 - i. 14 pairs of panties

- ii. 34 bras
- iii. 2 camisoles
- iv. 1 slip;

- A pillow case in the corner of the basement garage, containing, among other things:
 - a. 5 pairs of panties
 - b. 1 bra
 - c. 2 vibrators
 - d. Pyjama bottoms
 - e. Slip
 - f. 2 pairs of children's panties ;
- A green camera bag in the basement containing, among other things, a Sony camera and a pair of women's blue underwear.

309. The police also obtained warrants:

- a. To search the Nissan Pathfinder Mr. Williams was driving the night he killed Ms. Lloyd,
- b. To search his office at C.F.B. Trenton,
- c. To search a safety deposit box he shared with his wife, Ms. Elizabeth Harriman, at the Bank of Montreal, as well as to obtain his BMO bank records,
- d. To obtain his medical records at C.F.B. Trenton,
- e. To obtain his D.N.A., and,
- f. To obtain his cell phone records from Rogers Wireless for his Blackberry.

310. In his statements to Det. Sgt. Smyth, Russell Williams explained that on February 7th, 2010, when Det. Sgt. Smyth called him and asked him to come in to the Ottawa police station for an interview, Mr. Williams had planned on going back to Tweed that evening. He told Det. Sgt. Smyth that he was going to bring the undergarments he had stored in his Ottawa home as listed above with him to Tweed, to dispose of them, likely by burning them.

Further statements from Mr. Williams:

311. Det. Sgt. Smyth interviewed Mr. Williams again on the following dates:

- a. February 11th,
 - b. February 16th,
 - c. February 17th,
 - d. March 4th,
 - e. March 5th, and
 - f. May 11th.
312. As noted, during these interviews Russell Williams, confessed to the break and enters noted above and to the evidence that would be found on the two Lacie hard drives that he had secreted in the ceiling above the electrical panel in the basement of his Ottawa residence when he received the call from Det. Sgt. Smyth on February 7th, 2010. Det. Sgt. Jim Falconer and his colleagues in the e-crimes section of the O.P.P. examined the hard drives and Mr. Williams' computers. Before doing so, however, they created forensically identical working copies of them, which Det. Sgt. Smyth produced for Mr. Williams during his interview on March 4th, 2010. Using these identical copies, Mr. Williams then showed Det. Sgt. Smyth the location of each file folder containing evidence of each particular break and enter.
313. Det. Sgt. Smyth asked Mr. Williams whether he would have continued to commit criminal offences if he had not been caught by police. Mr. Williams responded that that was a difficult question to answer, but that he hoped not. He admitted that he likely would have continued breaking into people's homes, but hoped that he would not have attacked anybody else.
314. Det. Sgt. Smyth also questioned Russell Williams about why he confessed to having committed all of the offences. Mr. Williams continuously re-iterated that his intentions were to plead guilty to minimize the impact of his activity on his wife and to not amass large legal bills.
315. Det. Sgt. Smyth was suspicious that Russell Williams was being forthright by denying that, beyond the offences he confessed to, he had not been involved in any prior violent offences. Det. Sgt. Smyth's rationale was that it was odd for an individual to begin criminal behaviour of this nature at the age of 44. Mr. Williams repeatedly denied having been involved in any other offences. Det. Sgt. Smyth therefore questioned Mr. Williams about why he committed all of these offences beginning at such an age. Mr. Williams admitted that it was odd and that he was not sure what triggered this behaviour, but insisted that it was a very recent development. He explained that it began with an interest in stealing undergarments. This interest may have developed when he was in his twenties or thirties, but he did not act on it until he broke into his first house in Tweed in 2007.

316. Since his arrest, police forces across Canada and the United States have re-checked cold cases to determine whether Russell Williams' criminal behaviour might be linked to any unsolved crimes. The Violent Crime Linkage System (ViCLAS) has played a large role in these parallel investigations. To date, there has been no evidence that Russell Williams has been involved in any other past violent crimes.

Statements from Witnesses:

317. As part of their investigation, the police interviewed hundreds of witnesses. The following additional evidence is relevant to this case.

Master Corporal Shawn Thompson and Lieutenant Colonel Ross Fetterly, Canadian Forces:

318. Shortly after Russell Williams' February 7th interview with Det. Sgt. Smyth began, Det. Insp. McCrickard spoke with Master Corporal Shawn Thompson of the National Investigation Service (N.I.S.), being the investigative arm of the Canadian Forces military police. M. Cpl. Johnson advised him that Mr. Williams had not used his access "swipe" card on Base on either November 24th, 2009, the day of Marie-France Comeau's murder, nor on January 29th, 2010, the day of Jessica Lloyd's murder. Det. Insp. McCrickard passed this information along to Det. Sgt. Smyth before his confession. As noted, Mr. Williams initially maintained that he was sick with the stomach flu on January 29th. During his confession, however, he maintained that he slept on Base the night of January 29th. He later advised that he had, in fact, slept on the Base, but used a different key card. With respect to November 24th, he advised that he had gone to a meeting in Ottawa and thus was not on Base.
319. In a related part of the police investigation, Det. Cst. Ed Finn and Det. Cst. Dave Peterson, both of the O.P.P., interviewed Lieutenant Colonel Ross Fetterly, the Wing Administration Officer on Base and also Mr. Williams' subordinate. He indicated that, on the evening of January 28th, 2009, the night he broke into Ms. Lloyd's house, Mr. Williams left the Base in good spirits at around 9:00 p.m. On January 29th, at 5:52 a.m., he received an email from Mr. Williams saying that he had come down with a stomach ailment and would not be coming into work. He also asked Lt. Col. Fetterly not to tell his wife, if she called. As a result of this, Lt. Col. Fetterly had to cover a luncheon presentation Mr. Williams was scheduled to give that day to the Royal Canadian Air Force.

Lieutenant Commander Stephen Merriman, Senior Chaplain, C.F.B. Trenton:

320. As part of his duties as senior military chaplain, Lt. Com. Stephen Merriman visited Russell Williams at the Quinte Detention Centre on the morning of February 9, 2009. During the meeting, Mr. Williams advised Lt. Com. Merriman that there was audio and visual evidence concealed in his home in Tweed, in a piano. He wanted Lt. Com. Merriman to pass this information along to the police so that the police would stop searching his Ottawa home, and his wife could get back into it. He expressed concern about his wife and whether she would be taken care of, about his pension and about the fact that he did not want his father to come from North Carolina to visit him. The rest of the roughly half-hour meeting contained matters of a “pastoral nature” between Lt. Col. Merriman and Mr. Williams.

Jeffrey Manney – former colleague and friend of Russell Williams

321. Mr. Manney visited Mr. Williams’ cottage on September 19th, 2009. That night, they went to a Belleville Bulls hockey game where Mr. Williams dropped the puck at the ceremonial face-off. They returned to 62 Cosy Cove Ln and had dinner with Ms. Harriman. Before retiring for the evening, Ms. Harriman told Mr. Manney that Mr. Williams liked to go for walks before going to bed at night. At approximately 1:00 am, Mr. Manney went to bed and Mr. Williams went for a walk. Mr. Manney is not sure when Mr. Williams returned. [As noted above in the paragraphs dealing with the offences against Ms. Jane Doe, this is 2 nights after he assaulted Ms. Jane Doe and the same night he returned to Ms. Jane Doe’s residence only to find Mr. XXXX there, thus preventing Mr. Williams from entering.

Concluding remarks

Crimes that remain a mystery to police are ones where there are no clues and no evidence that point them toward a particular suspect. These crimes were the subject of intensive investigations by the police, but without having anyone to identify as a suspect, the police have little to work with.

In Ottawa there was no evidence and no clues that led to any suspects. Despite surveillance and undercover operations, the police still could not identify any suspects.

In Tweed, there was only one report of a break and enter, with nothing reported taken, 10 days after the fact, and no evidence or clues left behind. After the break and enter and sexual assaults to Ms. Doe and Ms. Massicotte, the police still had nothing to go on.

When Ms. Comeau was murdered, there was nothing beyond suspicion to link the crimes, and again, no clues left behind that cause them to identify Mr. Williams or anyone else.

The first break came when Ms. Lloyd disappeared. There wasn't much left behind then either. But the police observed those footwear and tire track impressions, and using those meagre clues, they managed to identify the perpetrator and build an overwhelming case against him for the 88 charges before you today. They did an outstanding job.
